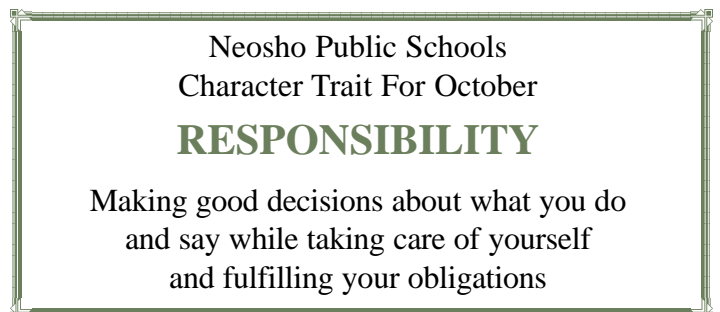

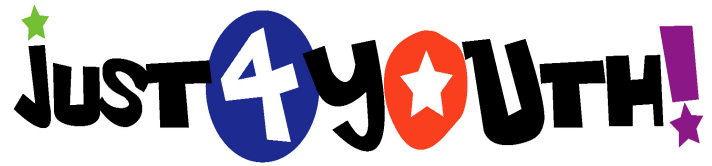



Planning in coordination with the deacons and church staff is on-going to consider additional classroom space in the building in the area now occupied by staff offices on the north side of the family room. Consideration is also being given to re-locating staff offices and providing a larger classroom that could serve as a storm shelter in a new building just north of the north exit of this building (near the front sidewalk).
