“My Kingdom is not of this world...”

—Jesus, John 18:36

Pilate’s discourse with Jesus begins with the question, “Are you the King of the Jews?” Historically we know that Pilate was fearful of riots and uprisings as he governed Israel. The next riot would probably cause him to lose his job. So, the questions he asks Jesus are aimed to see if Jesus was some sort of political leader who, if released, may incite the people toward rebellion. But, it was the Jewish leaders who were stirring up the trouble, and Pilate had heard rumors of this man healing, teaching, and leading a quiet group of people through the wilderness between Jerusalem and the Sea of Galilee.

So Pilate asks Jesus, “Are you the King of the Jews?” Jesus’ responses (which you can read in John 18) reveal that He is a much different King than Pilate (the world) would expect. He is King of a Kingdom that is “not of this world” and one that reveals truth.

Kingdom Vision is realizing that we are not of this world (See John 17:16). We are meant for so much more that only Jesus can reveal! Tye
