FYI: Overhead Electrical Service To Be Placed Underground

Soon you will notice work being done on the north side of the building. Empire Electric will be removing and replacing the overhead lines, capacitor bank and transformers with new underground service. They have agreed to do this without cost to us, a savings of thousands of dollars. We will still be responsible for the much lesser cost of a new ground pedestal and bringing the service from that pedestal to connect underground to the building.

On its own merits, this change is a significant improvement for us, in appearance, room for our children to play in the yard, and more importantly safety. A final consideration is that if construction of additional office spaces and classrooms north of the building are eventually decided upon, the removal of all nearby overhead service would be necessary at that time. In the future, we understand there is no guarantee that Empire would still be able to offer these changes to us without significant costs.

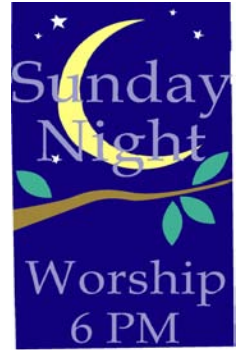
