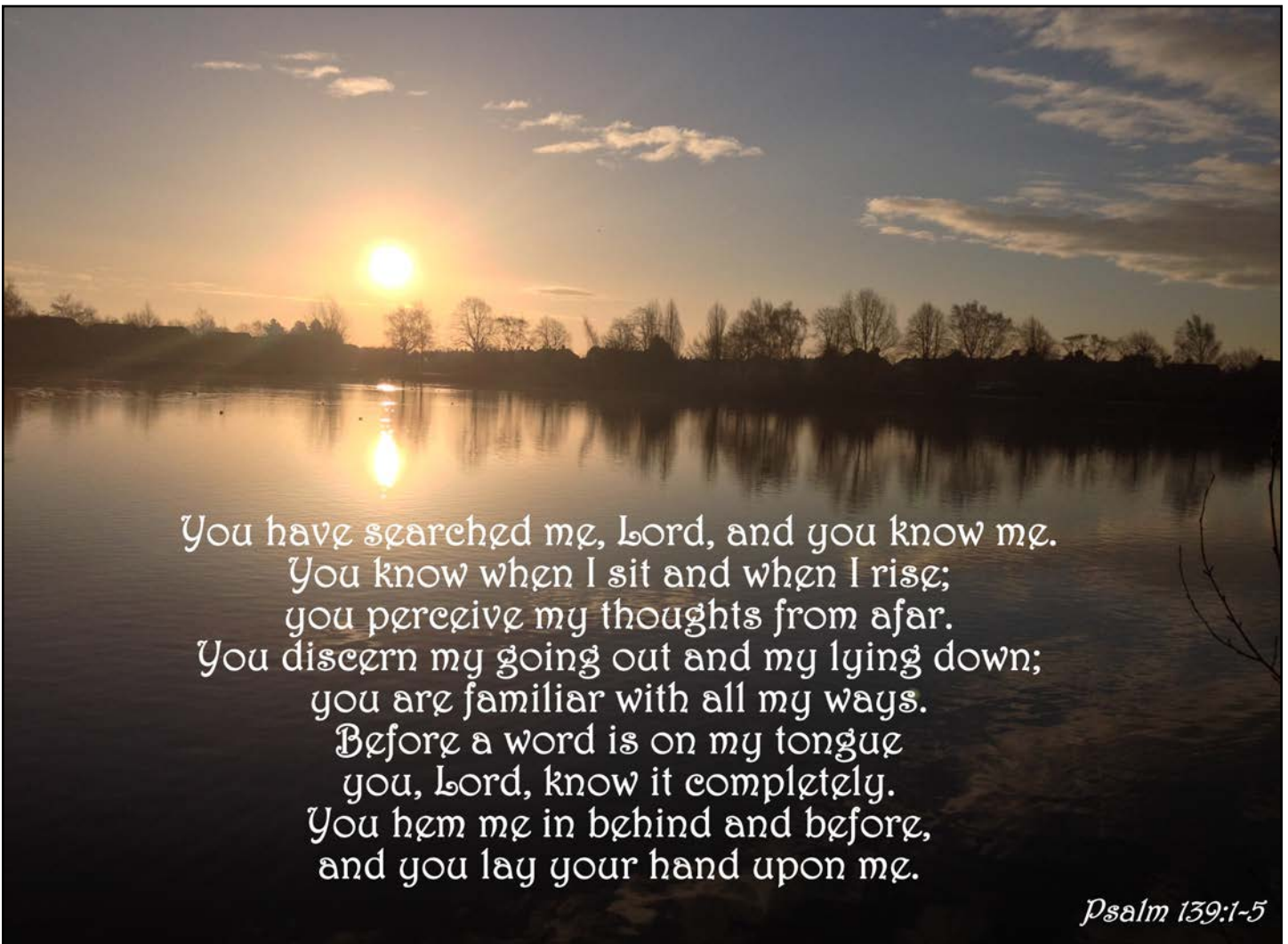

Story:

Telling Our Past,
Living in the Present,
Hope of Our Future with Jesus

What you wear definitely affects your behavior, how well you live into your story. When you are dressed well, you tend to act with more confidence and ease of comfort. Outfits that you are unsure of tend to create a story of unease that others can sense even when you don't say anything about how you feel. It is as if clothing is a personal language that symbolically expresses values, aspirations and hopes. This is why you should dress for the job you hope for when you are interviewing for a new job.

But all of us have known people who have faked their story by what they wear. We may have been someone who tried this. Their clothing did not reflect their true story as if they are wearing a mask, a costume. A great example of this was shown repeatedly in the show "Undercover Boss". The charade went both ways, affecting the story of the boss and the employees.

In Galatians 3:25-29, Paul is encouraging Christians to realize that following Jesus is not just a charade, but a change of our entire story - from our outward appearance to our heart and mind. We are not just simply putting on a Jesus costume. Following Him is to receive a promise, a changing to what we were created to be like before we started putting on our fake costumes of sin. He is changing us to be in His image as we were created to be!

But now that faith has come, we are no longer under a guardian, for in Christ Jesus you are all sons of God, through faith. For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise. Galatians 3:25-29
