Compartmentalizing Our Lives

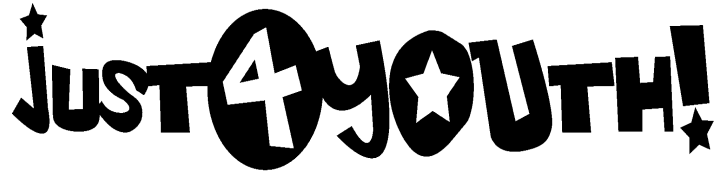

"And what is that there?" he asks pointing out a bushel in the corner. "Raisins," says the saleswoman, "but they are not for sale!"

There's nothing wrong with a customer in a grocery store who wants to individually wrap each piece of fruit. But it reminds me that sometimes we tend to do the same thing with our lives. We wrap up a piece of our lives and give it to our family. We wrap up another piece of our lives and give it to our employer. We wrap up another piece of our lives and leave it laying on th couch in front of the television set. Oh.....and we certainly don't want to forget God! So we wrap up an hour of our lives and give it to Him on Sunday morning.

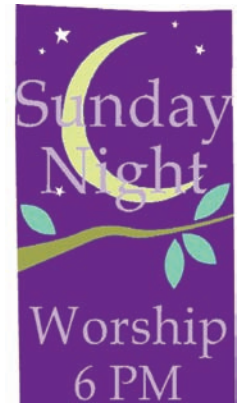
