Running To Help



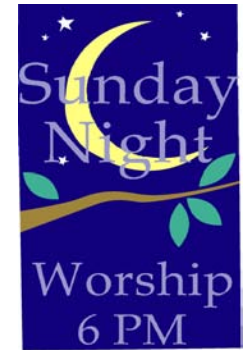
