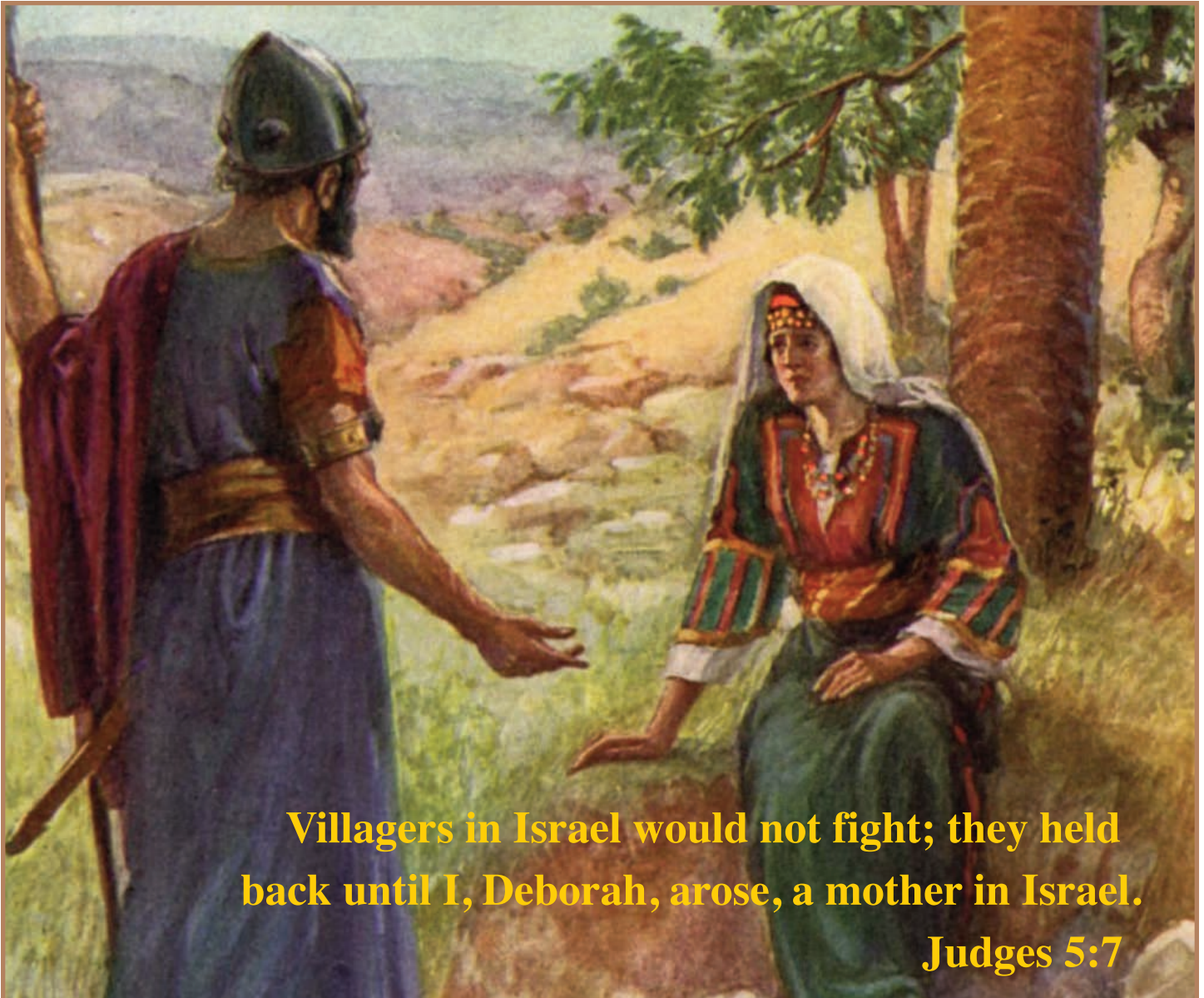

Rocketdyne Road Encouragement & Counseling Ministry Is Confidential

Ralph Madill serves as a counselor on staff for this church family. He is qualified and experienced and available to serve your needs.

You may call for an appointment at 451-6698 and ask for Carol Kruse or visit with Ralph personally about a time to meet.

Just a reminder: This program follows HIPPA guidelines for privacy. The appointment book is only available to Ralph and Carol. (Both Ralph and Carol are prohibited from talking with anyone about names or appointments) Both your name, the appointment and certainly the discussion with the counselor is treated with the utmost confidentiality. We have taken a step further and required persons on staff (and their spouses who sometimes stop by the building) to complete HIPPA training and they are bound by the same level of confidentiality and are prohibited from discussing with anyone at all (on staff or outside of the church building) anything they may inadvertently observe, including someone going in or out of the counseling office. The elders and ministers are also specifically EXCLUDED from any information regarding names of those receiving counseling or specifics of counseling. Ralph submits a monthly report which is limited to the raw numbers of counseling sessions that were held, not who or what specifically was involved in the sessions.

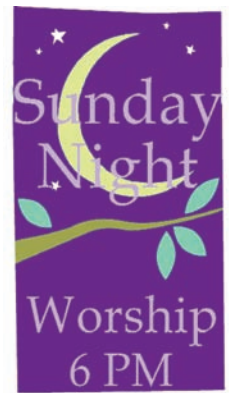
