

. . . persecuted Christians around the world. 10% of world Christian are persecuted (200 million); up to 150,000 Christians are violently killed each year; Christians suffer persecution in at least 60 countries; it is estimated that the Christian population of the Middle East (12 million) will drop to 6 million by 2020; More Christians were martyred in the 20th century than all other centuries combined; the number of Christians murdered for their faith doubled from 2012 to 2013 then nearly doubled again in 2014.

## The Author

The idea that Jesus is the author of life is powerful. Peter calls Jesus the “Author of Life” in his sermon recorded in Acts 3:15. The writer of Hebrews declares that Jesus is “the Author and finisher of our faith...” (Hebrews 12:2).

Jesus’ story is better than any story ever told. It is true and it is HIStory. His story is epic! The Bible clearly points to this truth from beginning to end as the key theme of all scripture is Jesus. 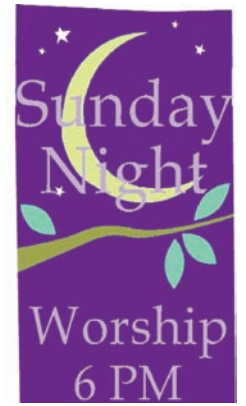
