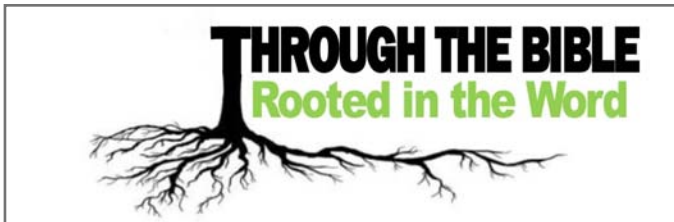

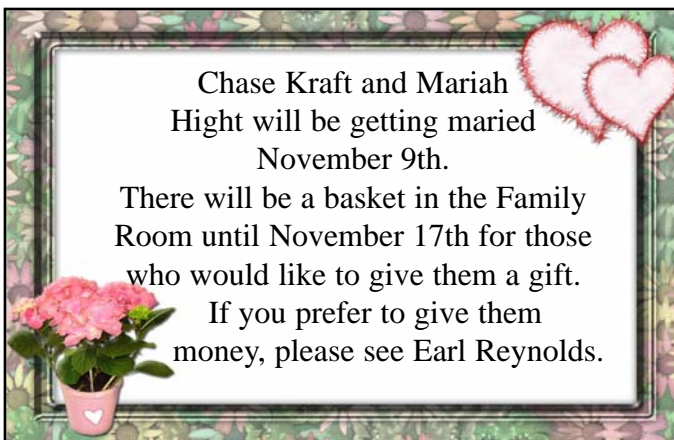




Our Day by Day Bible Reading this week had a really powerful translation of the end of 1 Corinthians 6.
