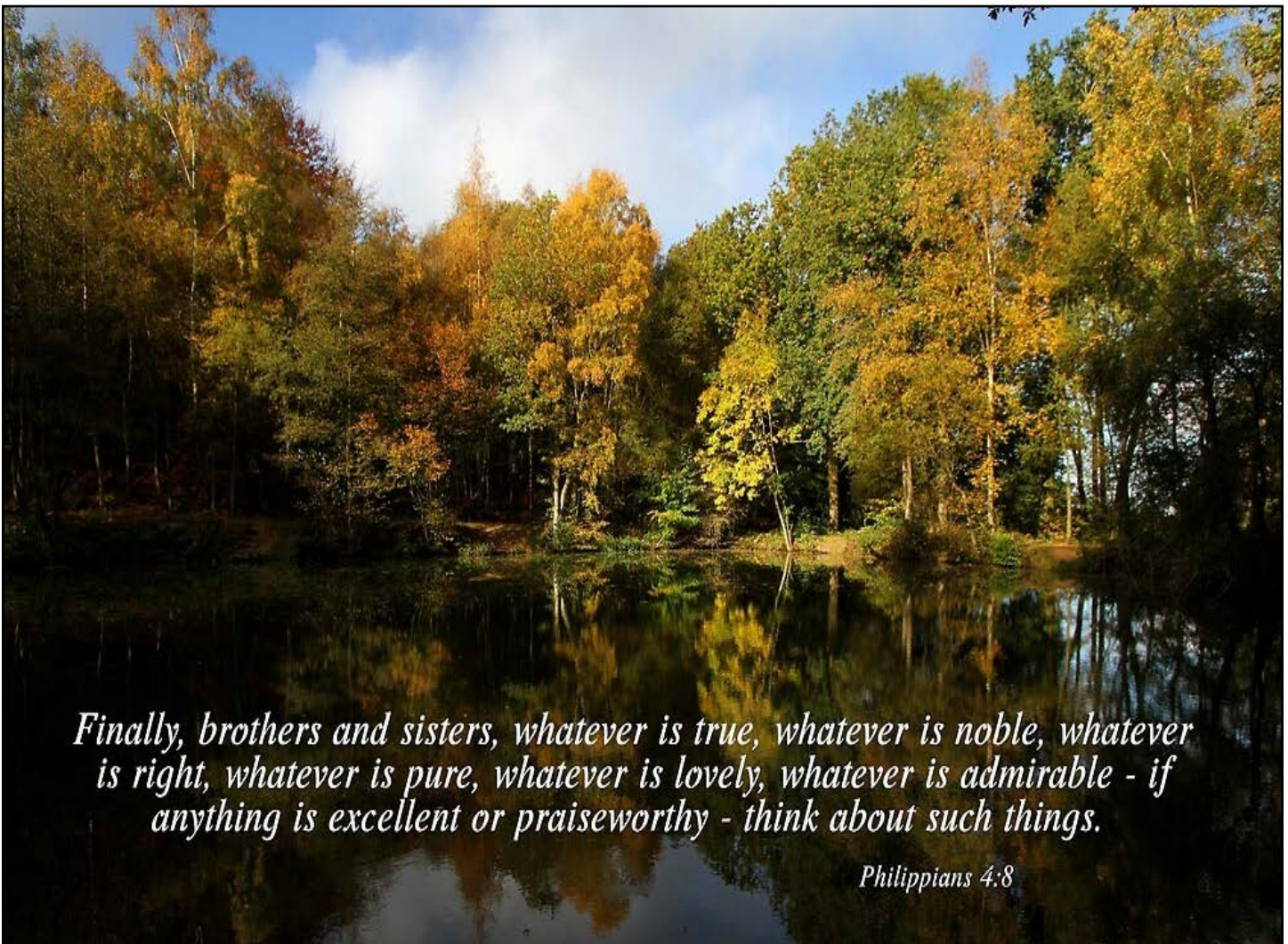

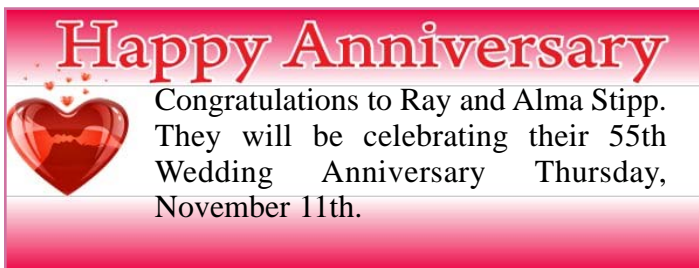

Paul's story of meeting some of the people he is most thankful for is rather interesting. In Acts 16 we can read Paul's story of wanting to visit old friends and share the good news about Jesus in places he has already been. But, he keeps running into problems with being able to preach (which he attributed to the Holy Spirit actually guiding him to a different story). One night, while he was up trying to figure out what was going wrong, he received a vision of a man asking him to come share the gospel in Macedonia. So he immediately traveled to Philippi, the capital city of the area.

In Philippi he meets people searching for God. Paul's story becomes a blessing to theirs as he shares the good news of God's salvation through Jesus! Their story, in turn, blesses Paul's by revealing that the conflicts he's been dealing with were because his story was much greater than he was even imagining!

Paul's story of confusion to right direction isn't very different from many of ours. God often places others into our lives to help redirect our stories by providing guidance and purpose. Like Paul, we should be thankful to God by letting them know how much He has blessed us through them.
