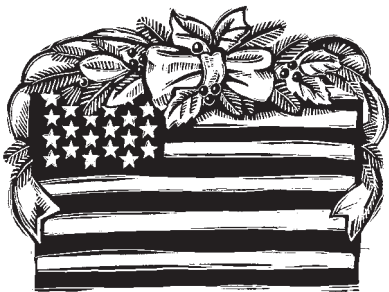
Congratulations

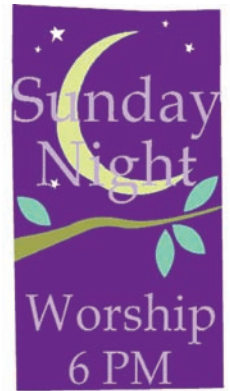
