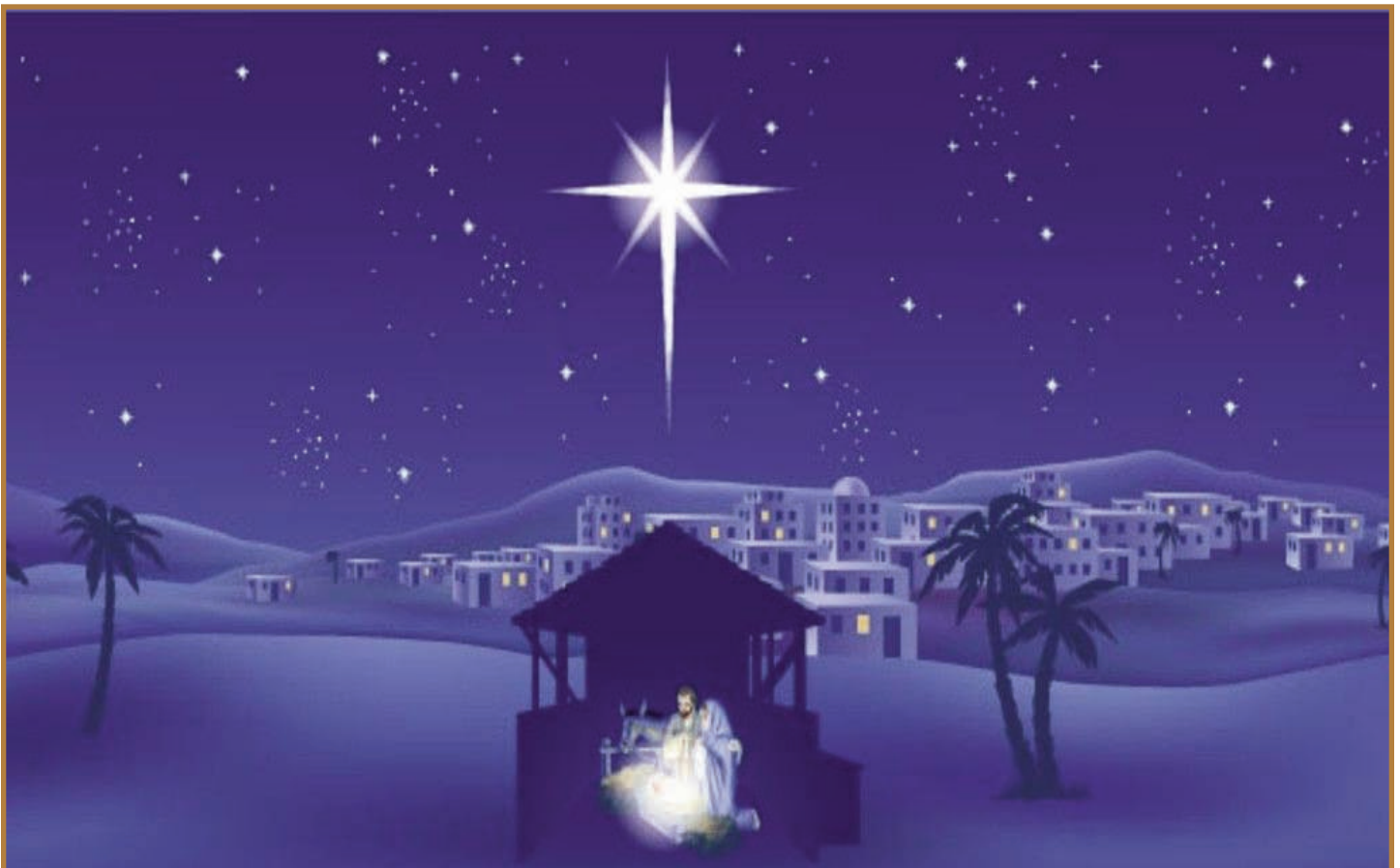

Mark Your Calendars

The acappella York College Concert Choir of York, Nebraska, directed by Dr. Clark Roush, will honor us by performing here at Rocketdyne Road Church of Christ on *Sunday evening, January 8 at 6 P M.* on their winter tour.

York College, founded in 1980, is a private four year liberal arts college affiliated with the churches of Christ. York offers numerous bachelor degrees and is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools. The campus is located in York, Nebraska, a thriving community just 45 minutes west of Lincoln. The student population consists of young men and women from about 40 states and countries.

The 66 member Concert Choir is chosen by audition and is the premier performing ensemble at York College. Members are required to meet a rigid rehearsal schedule in addition to maintaining a minimum grade level. The combination of dedication and hard work gives the Concert Choir a closeness found in few other campus groups. They travel 3,000 – 4,000 miles per year representing York College, the music department, and the choral art.

Dr. Clark Roush is in his 26th year as conductor of the York College Concert Choir. He is a professor of music and chairs the music department, which offers bachelor's degrees in vocal performance and music education. He received his B.A. from Harding University and his M.A. from the University of Iowa.

The choir will need homes to stay for Sunday evening. We will feed them at the building after the concert. See Cheryl Marion if you can keep some of these college students in your home.
