PURPOSE: To strengthen our confidence in our efforts to approach the lost with the Good News of Jesus Christ.

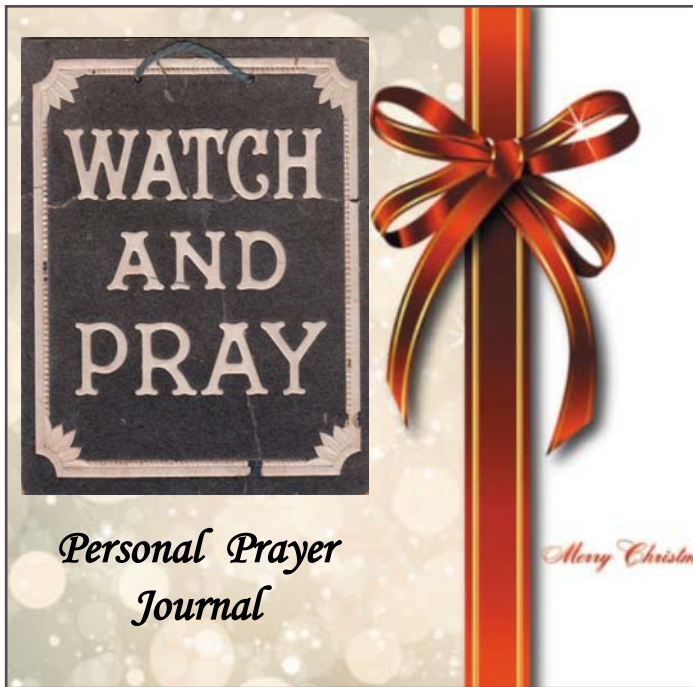
