

A Meal Eaten In Haste

It was at the conclusion of the Passover meal that the Lord Jesus gave us His memorial of bread and fruit of the vine. The Passover supper commemorated the day in which the Death Angel passed over the houses of the children of Israel when they were slaves in Egypt.

The Passover meal was to be eaten in haste, with their shoes on! (Exodus 12:11; Deuteronomy 16:3) It served as a reminder of the swiftness which attended their departure from the bondage of Egypt. It also reminded them that God brings about His plans suddenly and His people must always be ready to follow.

Sometimes when the bread which represents the Body of Christ and the fruit of the vine emblematic of His Blood are passed to us we feel uncomfortable that we might be taking the supper in haste. It is comforting to think that the Passover was meant to be eaten in haste.

It is also true that we need to be reminded that this world is not our permanent home. God may call us to the Promised Land at any time. Paul wrote: For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do show the Lord's death till He Come...(I Corinthians 11:26)

So until He comes or death calls, we remember Jesus' sacrifice each Lord's Day. And if we eat and drink sometimes a bit hurriedly, we can remember that it was at the conclusion of a meal eaten in haste that Jesus asked us to remember Him.

And we can be reminded that we should be ready to go at any time...

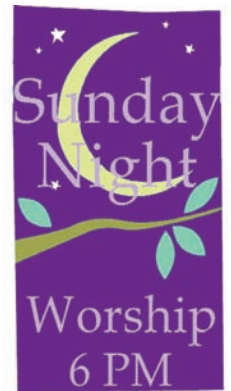
