







The Way

I recently finished a captivating book by Ted Dekker titled A.D. 30. I started reading this book last year, about the time that we were in a series about The Prodigal Son, because one of our members here had suggested it due to Dekker's intro to the book. The particular quote that stood out to her was this:

It is also said the shortest distance between a human being and the truth is a story.

Dekker's book seeks to tell the story of how incredibly true it is that Jesus is The Way for everyone who seeks to follow him. He does this through the use of historical fiction; where he uses real names and places while creating a fictional story that engages their stories to wonder about what it would be like to meet Jesus. If you like reading riveting stories, I highly encourage you to read this one.

One of the most powerful truths about following Jesus shows up near the end of the story. The main character is in a discussion with Stephen (I have wondered if Dekker wants the reader to think about the martyr whose story is in Acts 7) about faith and following Jesus as The Way, and one of the most important aspects of following Him in faith.

"There are two masters calling for your attention in every hour: the kingdom of this world symbolized by money, and the kingdom of heaven, which is spirit. Both are here—within and among us. You must choose to see the kingdom of heaven and abide. Until you forget and serve the other once again."

"Forget?"

He hesitated. "Unfortunately, yes. We forget far too often. But Yeshua's teaching calls to us still to remember."

May we remember, in every part of our lives, that Jesus is The Way!
