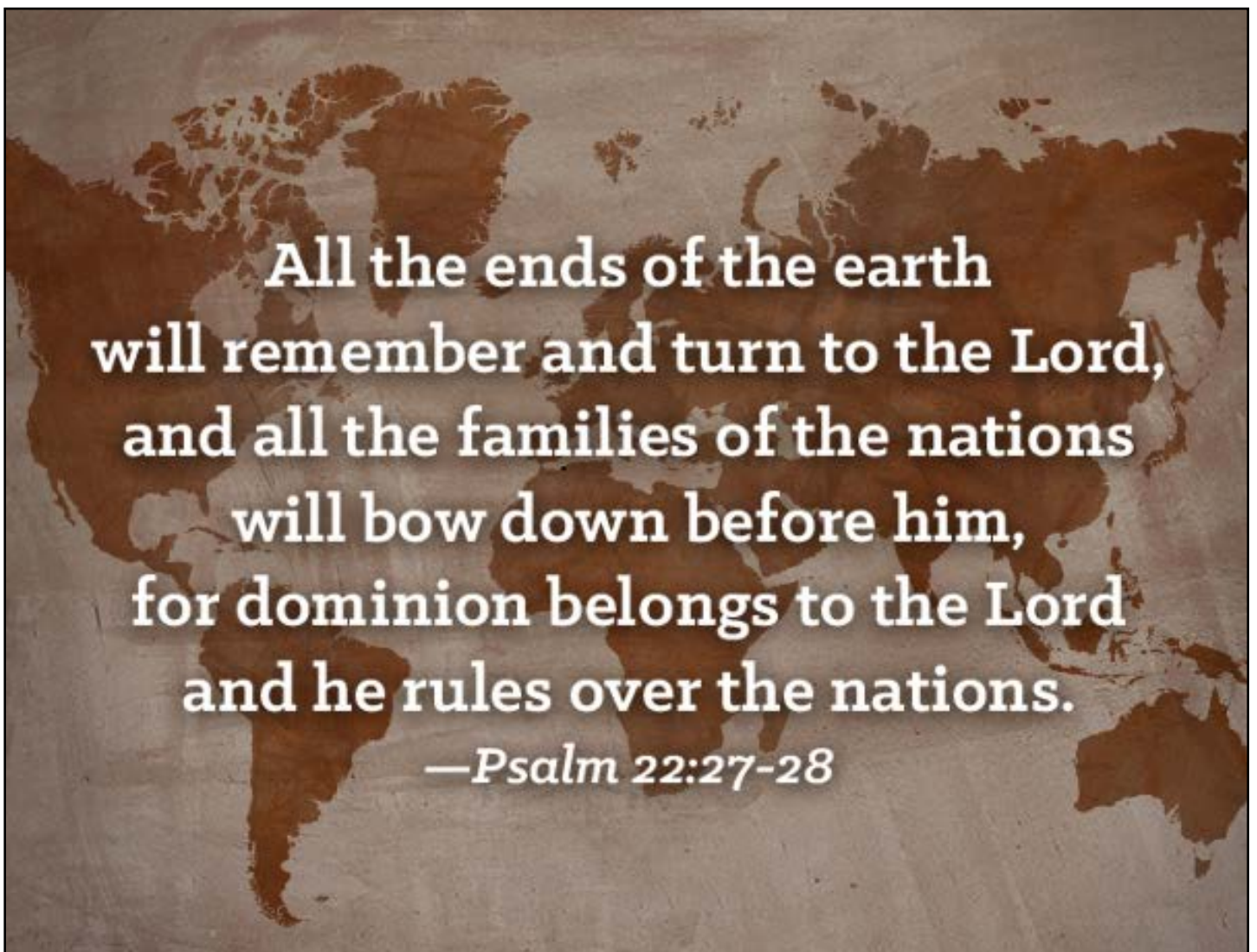

C.S. Lewis once said “Every day in a life fills the whole life with expectations and memory.”
