Per individual requests, we will be placing the following books in the library. I have included in this article book titles, author(s) names and a brief description.

You'll Get Through This by Max Lucado focuses on hope and help during turbulent circumstances, trauma and loss. We hope to have Ministry and Service presentations in the future that utilize key concepts mentioned in the book.

A favorite book regarding parent/child relationships is *Parenting with Love and Logic* by Jim Fay and Foster Cline. This book helps parents develop a parenting philosophy and enhance specific parenting responses. It focuses on parents and children developing mutual communication and problem solving skills.

An excellent book, *Happiness is a Choice* by Frank Minirth and Paul Meier addresses set-backs and loss that sometimes impact our relationships, health and spiritual lives. It explores non-productive patterns of thought that lead to painful thinking, a downturn in our emotions and possible depletion of our "feel good" neurotransmitters.

The Seven Principles For Making Marriage Work by John Gottman focuses extensive and innovative research of couples who experience rewarding relationships and couples whose relationship doesn't work well. The author shares what he calls the "Four Deadly Horseman" that are so detrimental to healthy relationships. He presents seven principles that work well and are the fundamentals of success relationships.

Systems-Sensitive Leadership by Michael Armour focuses empowering diversity without polarizing the church. It reviews systems of thought that are meaningful for individual members of the congregation and areas that enhance our collective worship. Ralph

The screening committee will then interview each man whose name has been submitted concerning his qualifications and willingness to serve and abide by the approval or disapproval decision of the church family.

The schedule for this procedure:

January 19th through February 9th--submit names to the committee

Committee interviews during the month of February
March 2nd--Committee submit names to the church family for consideration

March 16th and 23rd---voting by church family members on the names submitted

March 30th--Elder and Deacon installation.

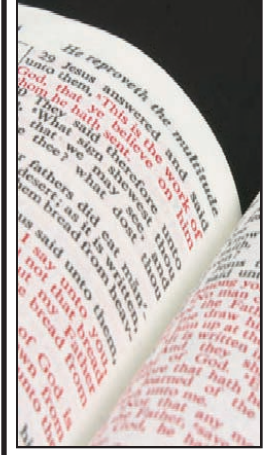
