BUILDING UPDATE

Progress on the re-modeling at 1111 Rocketdyne Road is right on schedule or even a little ahead at this time.

Demolition and removal of selected walls and ceilings has nearly been completed in the auditorium, foyer, selected classrooms and the kitchen area.

The auditorium is basically an empty shell at this time. It is ready for the new construction to begin. In fact, in some areas, new walls have already been framed in.

The kitchen area adjacent to the gym has been enlarged and the electrical contractor is already putting in necessary circuits to handle the changes there.

There is still much to be done, so pray for the safety of the workers and that they may continue to make good progress. Thanks to Rod Whorton for spending so much time keeping an eye on the project for us, and to Bob Hess and Jim Sexton for all the extra duty they have been pulling lately.

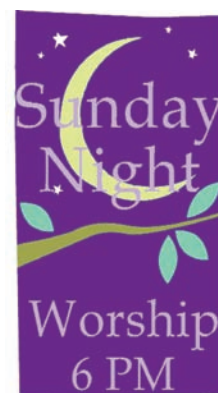
