

Have you ever reread a favorite book and enjoyed the read even more the second time?

I have learned that rereading books that I have really enjoyed is a huge blessing, though it wasn't easy to see this at first. The first time I reread a book was a little frustrating. My frustration came from the realization that I had forgotten so many of the details and I even had large plot holes in my memory. I kept catching myself thinking (and sometimes I even spoke this out loud), "I forgot about that!" It was quite awkward when someone was near and heard me talking to myself.

After a while I came to realize that my forgetfulness wasn't as bad as I thought. It wasn't a sign of head trauma. It was a revelation that I had forgotten that I did remember, but had not thought about that memory in a while. It was as if my memory was stored in a vault and a reminder of it had released it. The story became more detailed, had more depth and was more meaningful after reading it a second time and I allowed my forgetfulness to not be a weakness, but a revelation that I had stored this information.

If we are honest, there are times in our lives where we remember that Jesus is The Way after seeming to forget. If we doubt ourselves when this happens, our weaknesses get in the way. If we delight in the truth of remembering, we celebrate Jesus being the way as we notice new details of goodness of following Him, experience more depth in relationship with Him, and realize how meaningful it is that He is The Way! 
