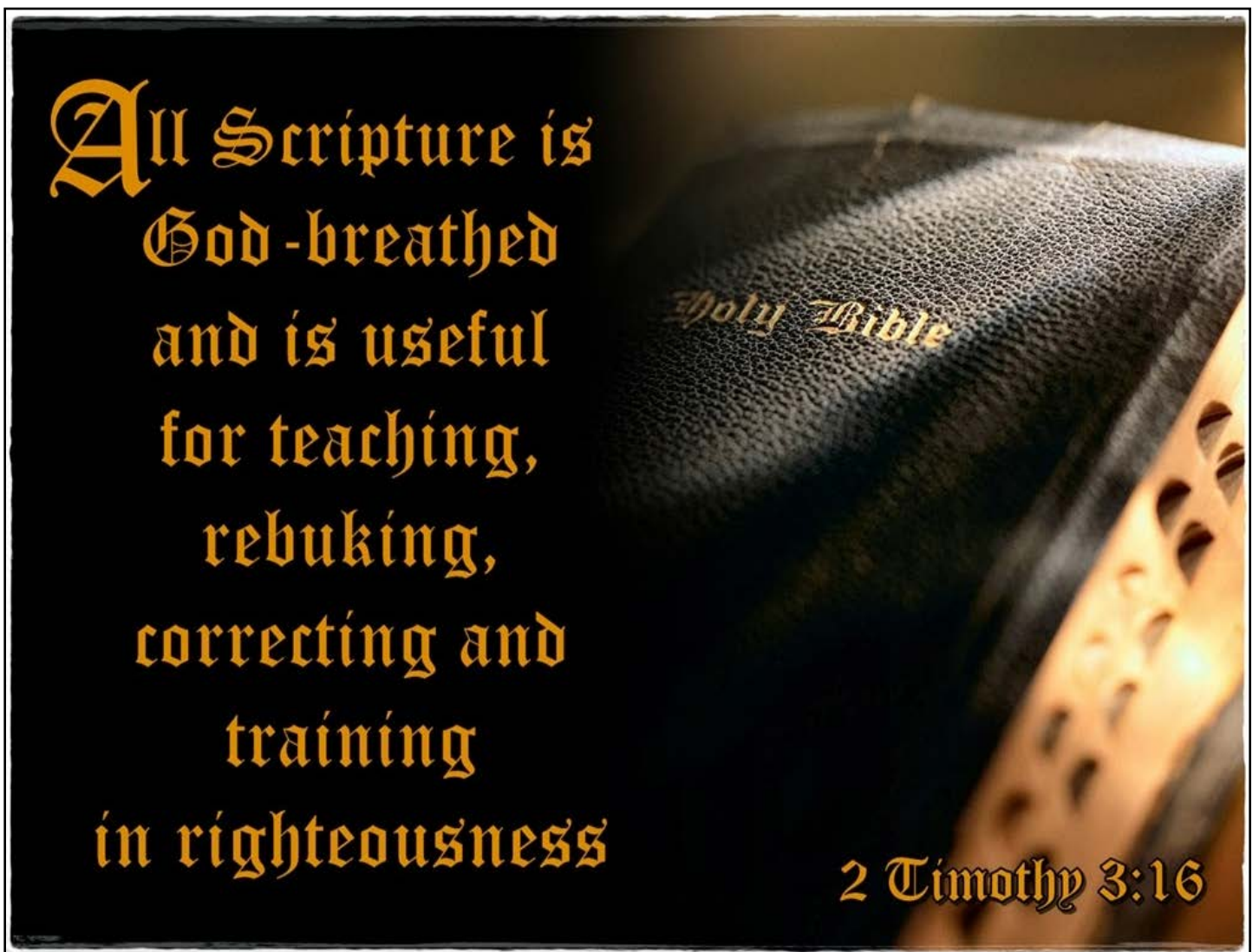

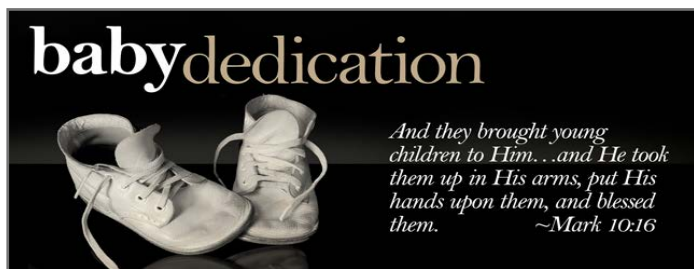


This Sunday is the day!!! January 24th
