Encouragement and Counseling Ministry

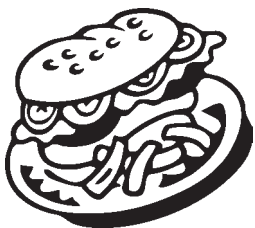

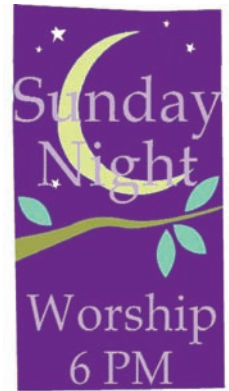
