Every three years the Rocketdyne Road church family selects new leadership. Existing elders and deacons are asked to decide whether they wish to continue serving and other men in this church family are asked to consider serving in these leadership roles.

1 Timothy 3:1 ~ "Here is a trustworthy saying: If anyone sets his heart on being an overseer, he desires a noble task." We see here that desire to serve is an important element for each man to serve as a leader in the church. Accordingly, the elders are asking each man who desires to serve as either an elder or deacon to present his name to a committee formed for the purpose of helping the man determine whether he is scripturally qualified to serve. Members of the committee include Jerry Cox, Ben Lane, Dale Naden, Jim Pyron, and Ray Stipp. Any man desiring to serve as an elder or deacon is now asked to submit his name to one of the committee members listed above by February 12th. The committee will gather the names and visit with each man who submits his name to be considered to be a new elder or deacon to verify his biblical qualifications. On February 26th the eldership will present the list of prospective elders and deacons to the church family to prayerfully consider. On March 12th and 19th the members of the church will vote on whether each man should serve. It has been determined that each man should receive a minimum of 85% approval by the membership in order to serve as elder or deacon. The voting process will be Yes, No, or Abstain. Abstain will be considered to mean that you don't know the individual well enough to make a determination. Accordingly, an abstention vote will not be counted as a no vote. We request all ballots be signed. Counting of the votes will be performed by Gary Cohu and Tim Stipp. Your vote will be kept absolutely confidential and destroyed after the tabulation of votes.

The elders and deacons approved by the church family will be presented on April 2nd. The Elders

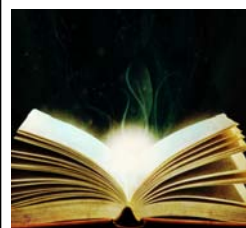
