The Wednesday Evening Meals have been cancelled until the end of March.



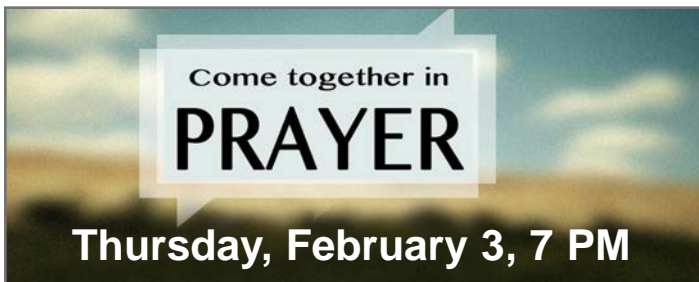
