Congratulations to Wil and Dawn Dabbs. They will celebrate their 58th Wedding Anniversary February 2nd.

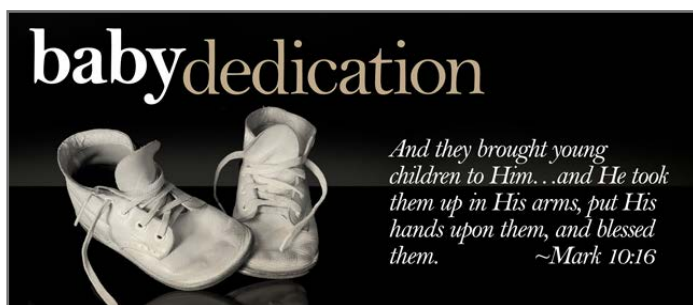
# WHAT'S HAPPENING NEWS IN THE YOUTH GROUP
