Most of you are aware of the church shooting last Sunday at the West Freeway Church of Christ in White Settlement, Texas. We share in mourning the lives lost on that day. We are sure that many of the churches throughout the country, as well as us, are reviewing the event for guidance on what can be done to protect church members while attending worship or involved in other church activities.

While we have had many discussions and have taken measures previously to be prepared to deal with a situation like what happened in Texas, there are several things learned from the video and reporting from the tragedy that might be helpful as we review our present security measures in an effort to be prepared. We want you to know that we are reviewing our plan and seeking further recommendations from security professionals to make whatever adjustments that might be helpful.

We have learned from this and previous events that being pro-active in addition to being reactive is vitally important. Each member of our church family can play a role in our security by being watchful of potential problems. We have no indication of any problems on our immediate horizon but if you know of situations or individuals that might become dangerous, please provide that information to any elder or deacon. We will be sensitive to your privacy but we will investigate the information provided thoroughly.

May God protect us and bless our ministries as we seek His Kingdom first.

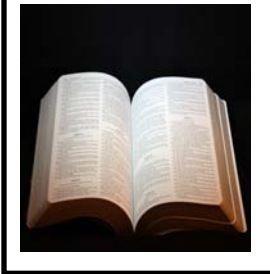
