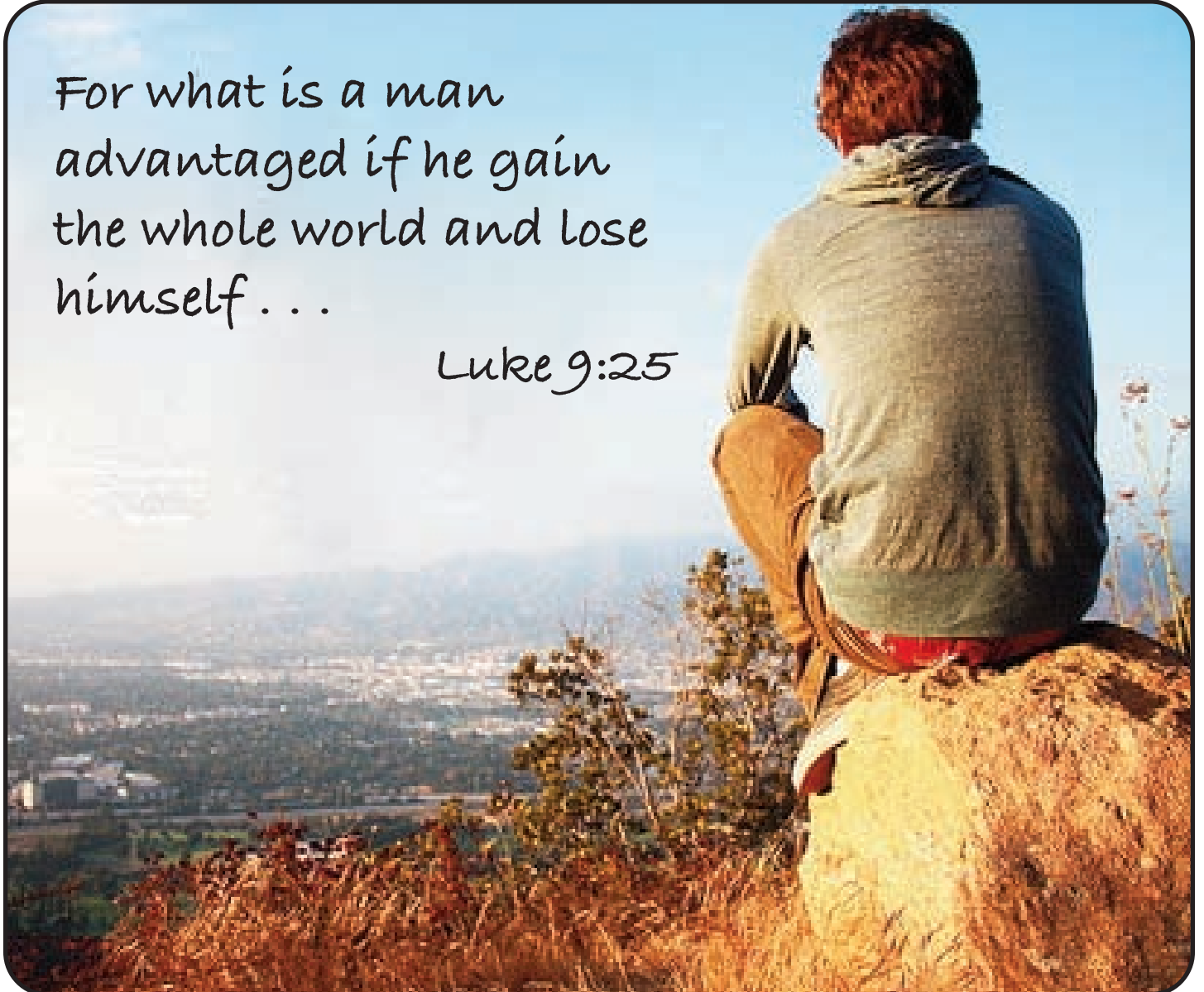

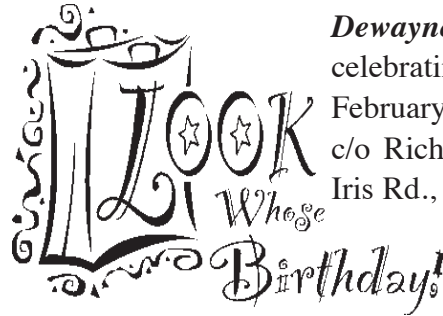

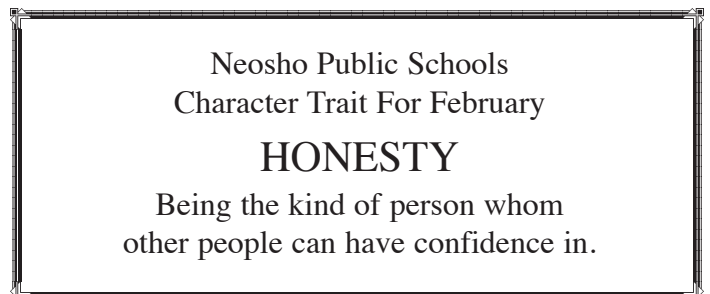
### Sympathy

## Encouragement and Counseling Ministry

Last Sunday, our auditorium class touched on a very interesting topic. Members of the group explored possible reasons that some people appeared more merciful and gracious on a daily basis while others regularly focused on a negative theme and had a tendency to blame and criticize. This is something that I have reviewed, researched, observed and helped youth and their families work through for over two decades. This is a complex issue. In some situations it may be related to unresolved loss. All of us at some point have been “stuck” in an “anger-directed-outward stage” of the grief process.

The following are a few characteristics that may be observed when we experience this stage. We may:

- realize that loss has occurred and it can't be undone.
- minimize our own mistakes and focus on the mistakes of others.
- appear disruptive, especially when something suddenly changes or goes wrong.
- “push against” or act in a defiant manner attempting to discredit others.
- walk off, leave or run away when there is a problem.
- exhibit insulting and/or provoking behavior.
- display high risk, destructive and/or threatening behavior.

These characteristics may be observed even if an individual experienced loss in early childhood and does not remember it. The following are stages/phases of the grief process: Generally, the initial stage is Shock and Denial, possibly followed by Bargaining, possibly followed by Anger directed Outward, and then possibly Anger directed Inward. The final stages, Genuine Grief and Resolution are when healing, forgiveness and kindness develops in our lives toward self and others. The purpose of the Encouragement and Counseling Ministry is to help individuals, couples and families to work through changes, loss, negative attachments and stressful circumstances. 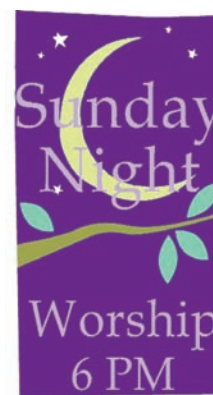
