### **Love Does**

Several years ago, my understanding of Kingdom Vision was changed when I learned more about love. I had this weak view of love as an emotion that appeared, almost magically, a result of just the right moment that was destined by some sort of fate or whim of occurrences. I'm glad I learned I was wrong because love is so much more than I had imagined.

My eyes were opened after reading a book by Bob Goff called "Love Does". Bob (I can call him this because I have met him personally and even received one of his famous hugs) writes about how he and his family have changed their direction and purposes in life in order to truly live in God's Kingdom. They simply decided to love others, regardless of the circumstances, so that others may know of God's love. In doing this, Bob learned that love requires courage, action, imagination, and that it is a choice. Bob found the word love to be a verb and not merely an adjective of emotion. When love was acted upon, the emotion was overwhelmingly better. So, his family loved his neighbors by creating a neighborhood parade where no one was allowed to watch, but everyone was invited to be celebrated. His kids loved world leaders by inviting them over to their house and talking about their hopes and dreams of making their countries better. Bob found that this good life was only possible because God loved him first.

God loves you! It's not just a random emotion that magically happened by circumstances being just right. He's always loved you and always planned to love you! How will you love Him and His Kingdom in return because He so loved you first?
