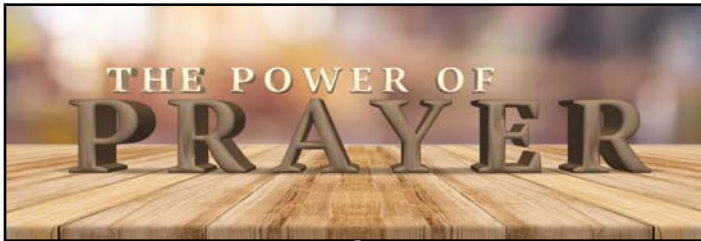
A Scarlet Thread

As a follower of Jesus, I have often wondered why there is so much violence in the book of Joshua. Jesus did tell us to love our enemies, right? I'm learning that my focus may have been wrong causing me to miss the beauty of God's hope in redeeming a land of promise.

At the end of Joshua 5, Joshua is near Jericho and encounters "the Commander of the Lord's army." The angel tells Joshua that he is neither for Israel nor against Israel, and then he says something even more strange. He tells Joshua to take off his shoes for the place where he is standing is holy. Why didn't he say this at the beginning of the conversation? What is so special about Jericho? There aren't any fiery bushes around! And, why have the Israelites march around the city for 6 days and then 7 times on the 7th day when the wall could have come down on the first day?

I'm learning that the answer is in the redemption of a prostitute and her family because of faith. What if 7 days of worshipful marching was grace, that maybe more scarlet threads would appear in windows and more of the wall would stand? The story that God has always been telling is that His desire is for people to turn from the corruption of sin, trust him, and be an active part of his mission of redemption. This is the truth of the scarlet thread. Rahab's life was redeemed from prostitution to becoming one of God's people.
