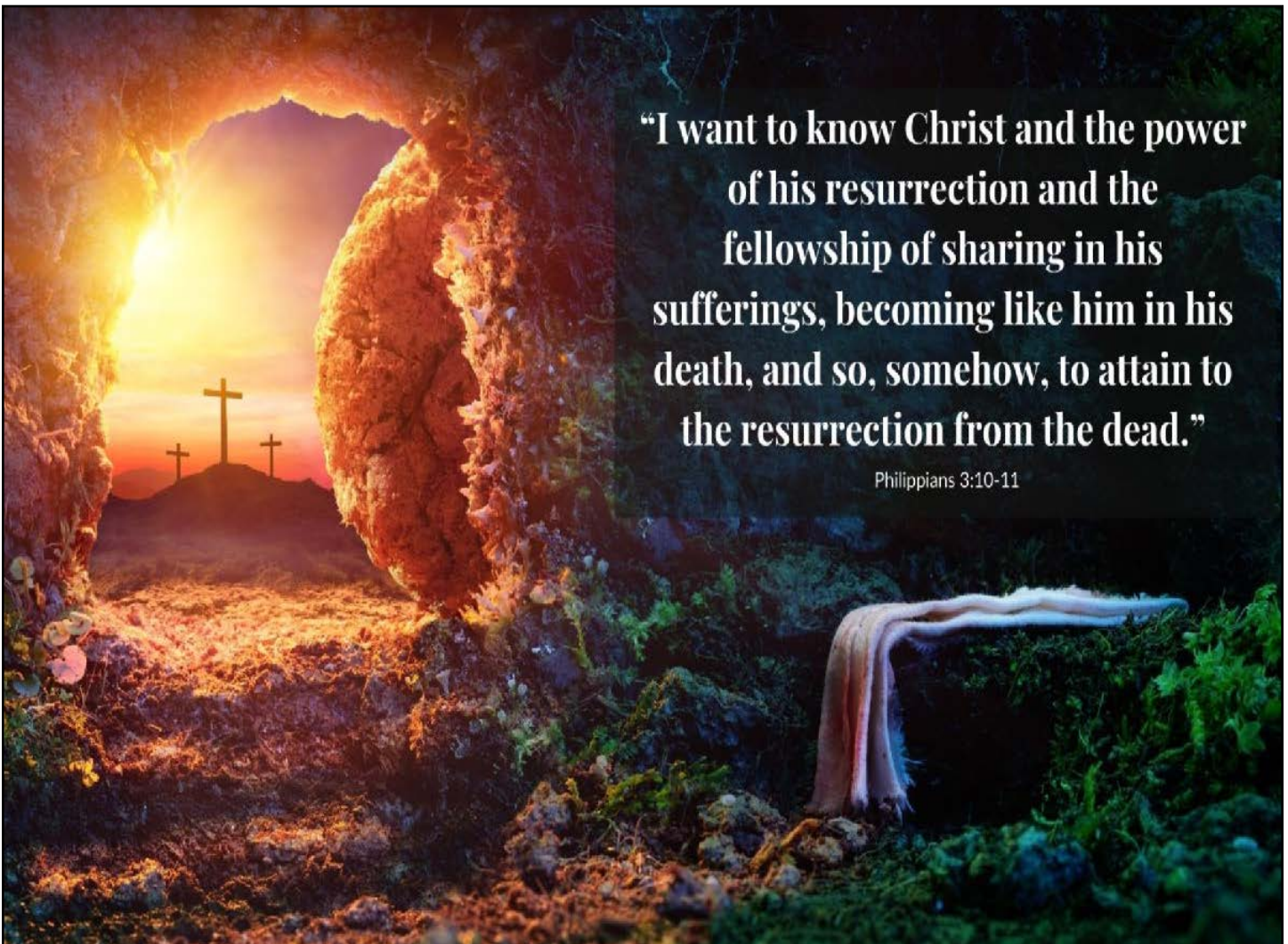

## The Way

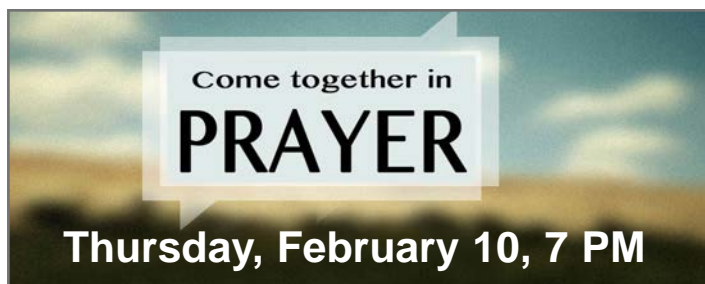
