Remember the good feeling of having the assignment prepared and ready to hand in on time. And the panic of knowing it was to be late or a subpar effort. Looking back on our experiences we see a connection between the enjoyment of the teacher and the class and our eagerness to complete the assignment given.

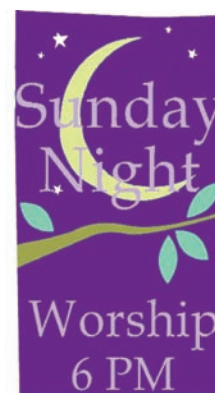
