Report From India

Thank you so much for helping me with the mission work in India. This was my 20th trip in the past 23 years and I feel like we accomplished many good things. I spent time preaching at night in the villages. The Lord added 25 new souls in baptism. Five orphans were given help with school supplies. Medical aid was given to three brethren. Seventeen flashlights and 30 pens were given to students, teachers, preachers & cooks. I spoke several times in our local Bible School. We currently have 25 students. We wrote, translated and published 1000 copies of "The Encourager" newsletter for church leaders. I helped and encouraged some of our congregational development trainers, students and local India Bible School teachers. The current greatest needs are Bible school materials for children, congregational development workbooks for Bible classes and more issues of "The Encourager" in the Telegu language. It is not my intention, unless the Lord has other plans, to return to India in the next few years. Even though my upcoming mission work will be done through the internet, this trip was needed to tie up loose ends and see what is needed for the future. Thanks again for caring enough to strengthen churches in India. It is our goal to teach the message to 100 million Telegu speaking people in India. Stephen Garman

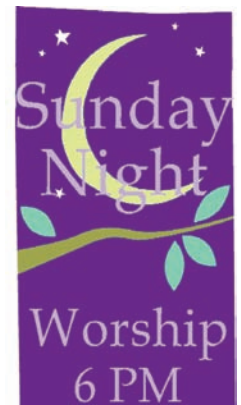
