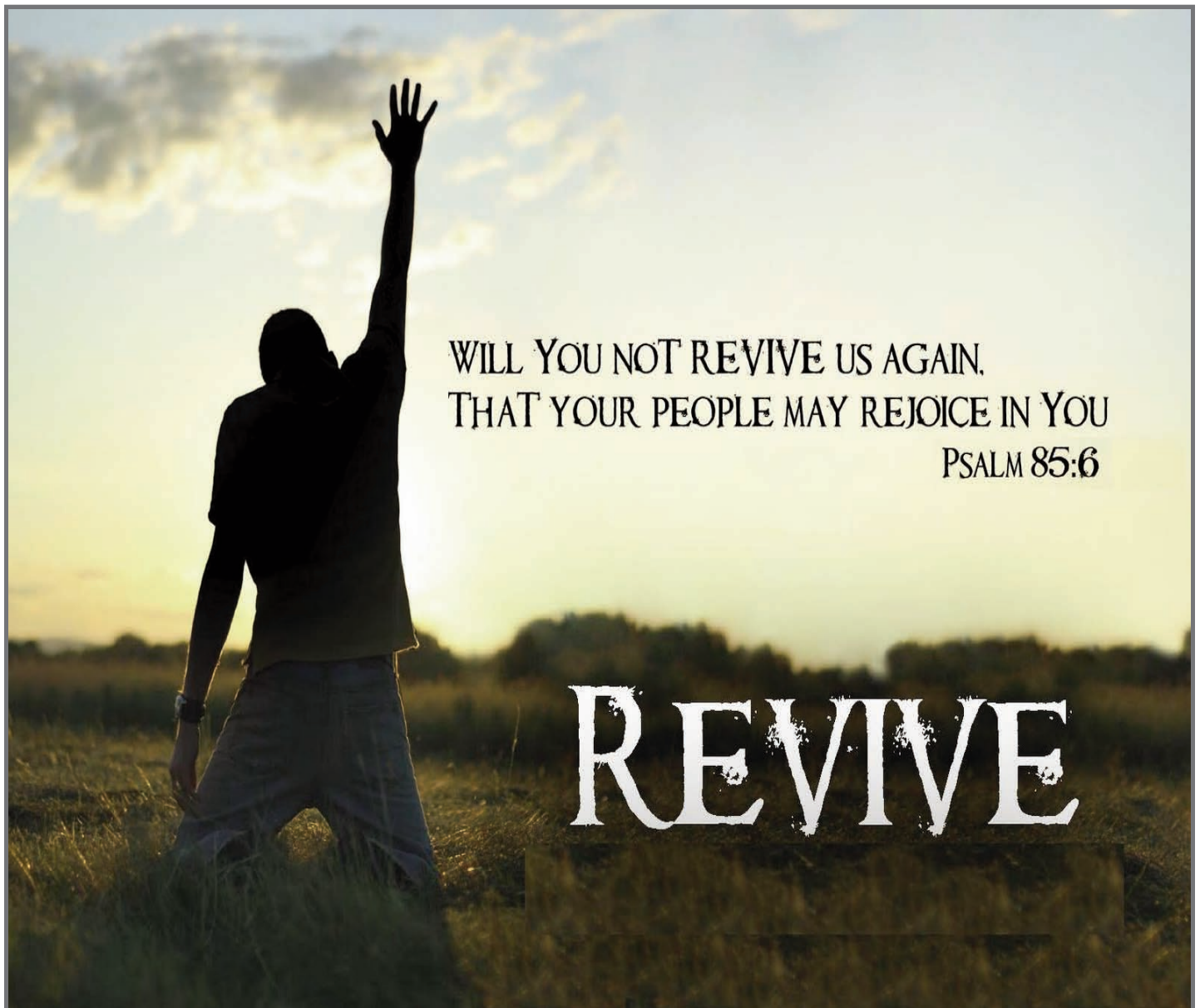

COURAGE

Being brave when faced with a difficult or scary situation and standing up for what you know is right and what you believe in.

WHAT IS REVIVAL?

I think it would be incorrect to think of revival as something that happens to those outside of God's Family.

We wrongly think of revival as evangelism, because increased conversions of non-Christians usually accompanies it. But conversion and revival are related, yet separate distinct things.

Revival can only happen in the life of a Christian. Those who are unconverted cannot be revived for they have yet to be made alive in Christ – born again.

A paramedic can only revive someone who has been physically alive. God can give revival only to those who have been made alive in Jesus.

The word revive says it all if we break it down. Revival is a compound word: RE=again and Vive=live! To Live Again!

Revival is for us who are alive in Jesus but are lagging in faith, slacking in good works and struggling in sin.

Revival can come to a church, but only if it comes to each member. That's because revival is about the heart.

God's plan for revival?

It begins with new-found humility of heart that leads to repentance, that leads to forgiveness and a clean heart, that leads to room in our hearts into which Jesus pours His Spirit and that in its turn leads to spiritually exciting lives of victory and power, love, joy and peace!

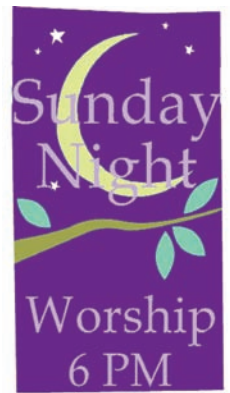
