

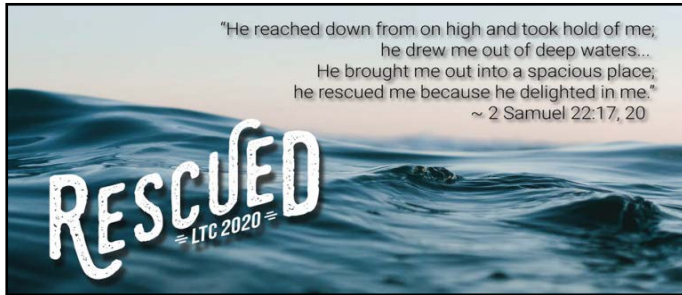

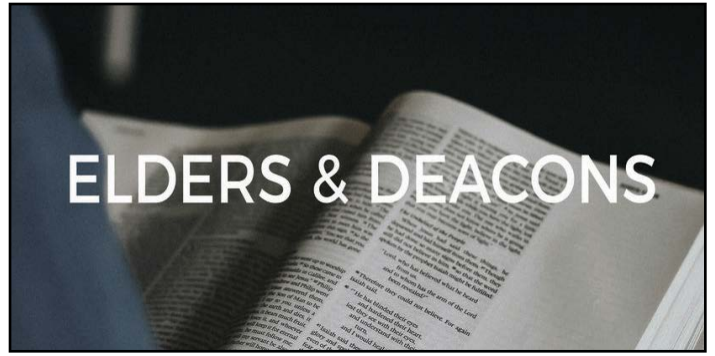

From The Elders

Romans 13:1-2 states "Everyone must submit himself to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established. The President of the United States has requested that all group meetings include not more than 10 people in order to help reduce the spread of the Covid-19 virus in our country for a period of time. While this is not mandatory, we feel we have the responsibility to help with the physical well being of our brothers and sisters. Also, we feel we should comply with the requests of our government when those requests are not in violation of God's word and appear to be for the benefit of all citizens of our country.

Accordingly, we are cancelling all worship services and church meetings at Rocketdyne Road in compliance with the maximum of 10 people limit for the time being. We will be watching developments in this event for guidance on what we can do to, once again, reinstitute worship services at our building.

We have developed an opportunity for you to participate in our worship online or on Facebook Live beginning this next Sunday (March 22nd). You will receive another FYI explaining how you can access worship at Rocketdyne Road by either of these methods.
