## Encouragement and Counseling Ministry

"I have enough confidence in Christ to order you to do that which is proper... but without your consent I did not want to do anything that your goodness should not be as it were by compulsion, but of your own free will". This was written by Paul to Philemon during a critical time in his life and concerning an important relationship and situation.

Paul effectively addressed "How to handle both relationship and task elements" in our spiritual communication with one another. There are times when we have become so task oriented, operating under the assumption that "someone needs to comply" with our requests, that we have diminished the very service that we intended to help.

During a crisis or a set of highly sensitive circumstances, it is critical for those with the most experience and knowledge to take charge of a situation until it is resolved. However, it is detrimental to the "spiritual make-up of a relationship" if we are task oriented on a continual basis. Making compulsory statements, without empathy and an awareness of relationship dynamics, generally leads to deficit motivation, diminished responsiveness and decreased performance.

Let's protect one another's free-will. If someone is "frequently making critical supervisory statements," let's speak with them before conflicts develop. Merely share with them what you "heard and saw" in an objective manner and engage them in a conversation characterized by interest, honor and respect. Be very cautious if you find yourself "talking with someone about someone else" in a negative manner due to the possibility of forming a negative alliance. Let's be observant and responsive to how God is working in our life and the lives of those around us.
