COURAGE

Being brave when faced with a difficult or scary situation and standing up for what you know is right and what you believe in.

LET THE PEACE OF GOD REIGN

Jesus promised to give us His peace – the very peace He showed in every circumstance of life.

We know how many things disturb our peace. Big things, like health, finances and family problems. And little things, like interacting with others in conversation at work, at home, or even at church.

So many disturbances tempt us. And before we realize how it happened! We have stepped out of the life of JESUS and into a life directed by SELF. On our own now, we sin so easily in so many ways.

How can we keep the peace of God ruling in our hearts?

We must, at the first inkling of some disruption of peace in our hearts, blow the whistle and stop the game. The conversation need not necessarily end, nor do we need to jump up and run out of the room.

Instead, we are quietly blowing the whistle to ask just why my peace is being disturbed.

That's easy you say – It's the person who is upsetting me!

Yes, but it's your heart, so your choice to let the peace of God rule or lose that peace by asserting *yourSELF* in whatever way will make you feel better.

So I blow the whistle. There's a foul. Now what?

Simply talk to Jesus. Ask Him to show you exactly why your peace is beginning to depart from your heart. It will always be something in SELF that has been aroused.

Now confess that lack of humility and brokenness that you have been shown and ask for the cleansing of the blood of Jesus. Then step back into the situation with the heart of Jesus in mind.

The peace of God will be restored in your heart. – the very heart of Jesus inside of you - will come upon you by the power of the Holy Spirit.

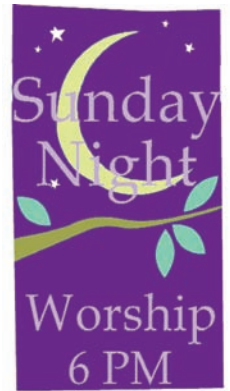
