stretch your imagination...**

The manger was near Bethlehem’s sheep pastures, and the shepherds were summoned by heaven. They were Jews, caring for sheep. At the same time the priests had their eye on breeding a particular quality of lambs, those without spot or blemish.

Now fast forward thirty-three years. When Jesus is making His triumphal entry into Jerusalem, the shepherds are bringing in the sheep, and particular attention is paid to the candidates for the Passover sacrifices. As Jesus is being tried by Pilate, the priests are carefully examining those sheep. As they are satisfied they are saying, “I see no blemish in this one...” Perhaps about that time Pilate is saying, “I find no fault in Him.” As the blade is put to the throats of the lambs, the nails are driven into the hands of Jesus. He was, after all, the perfect Lamb of God.

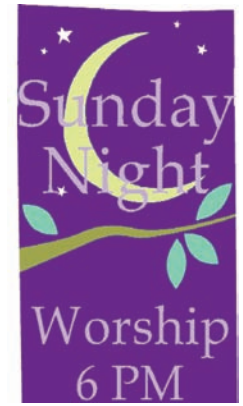
