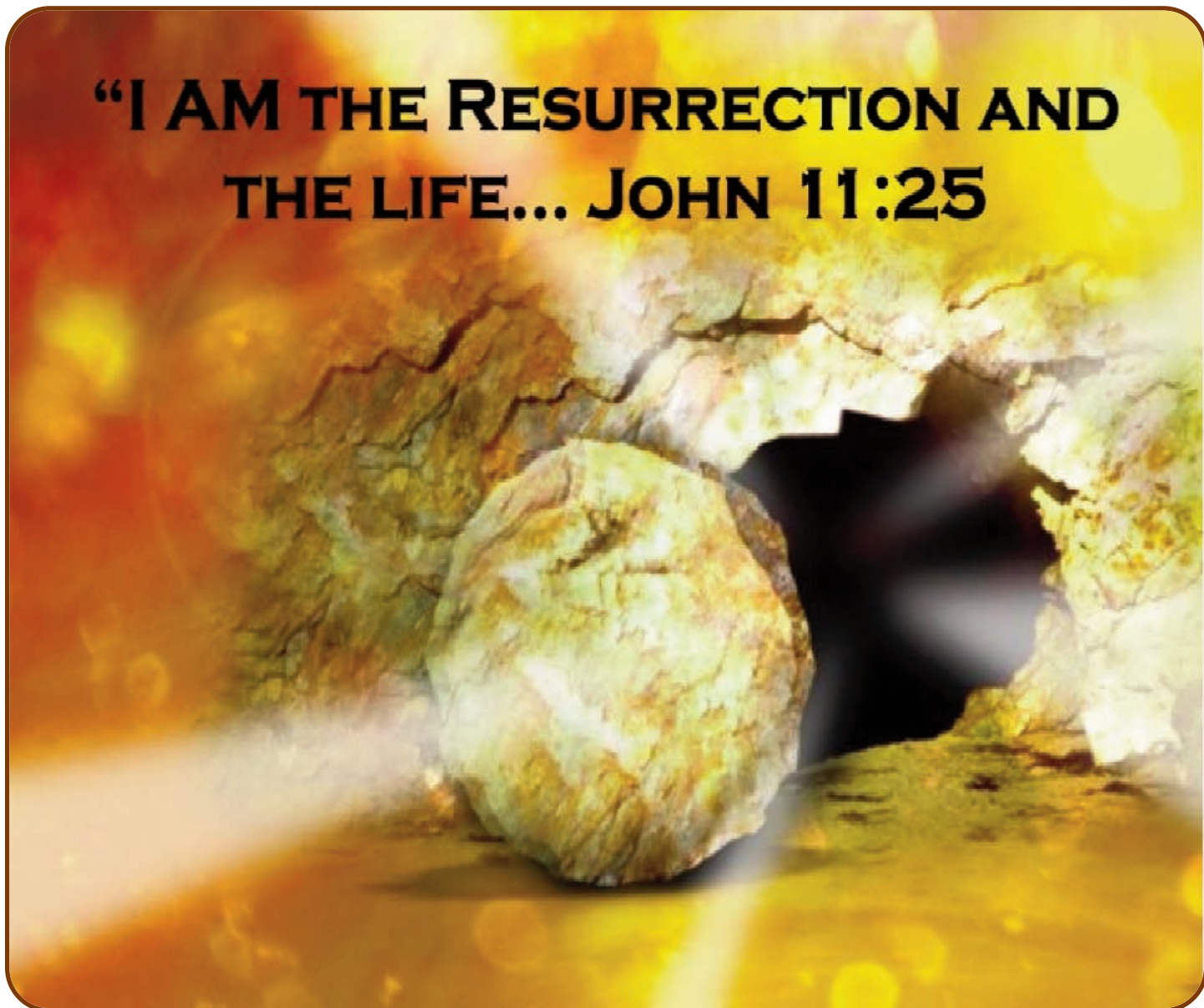

To save the world, God sent a Baby. To reveal His Kingdom, Jesus called for a little Child. To take away sin, Jesus went to a rugged Cross. To overcome death, Jesus left an Empty Tomb. A baby, a child, a cross, an empty tomb remind us that the power of God is often expressed in surprising ways.

*He chose the lowly things of this world and the despised things...so that no man may boast before Him. (I Corinthians 1:28)*

Each Lord's Day, as we eat and drink the simple emblems of unleavened bread and fruit of the grape the lesson comes home again. The power of this remembrance of Jesus is not in lavish display or any other grand ideas we usually associate with a great memorial.

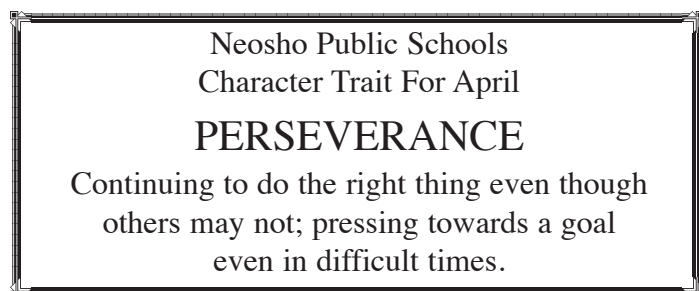
