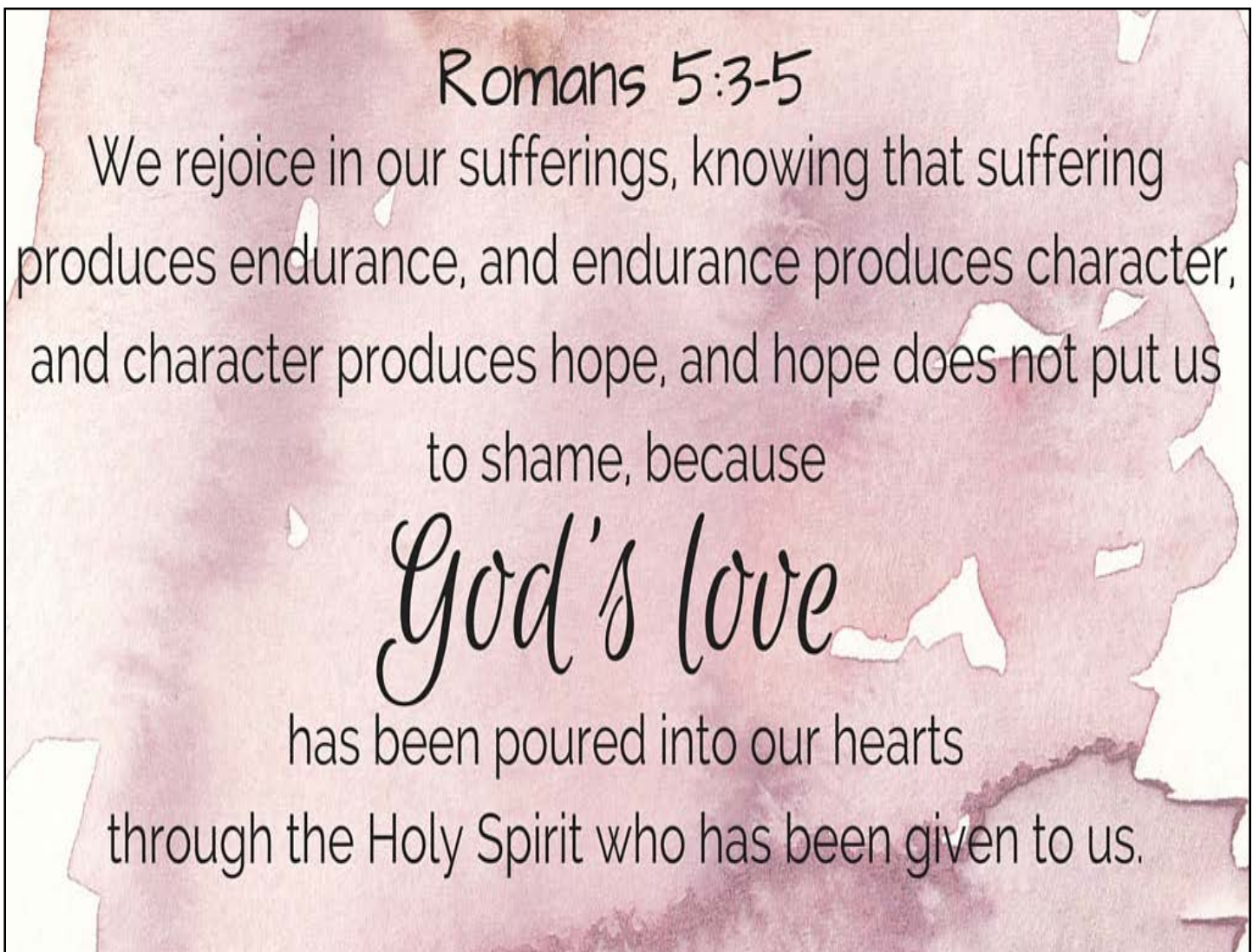


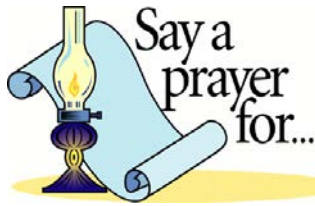

**Story:**

When googling dynamic vs static character, I came across this definition: Dynamic characters are the opposite of static characters; while dynamic characters change throughout the story, static characters stay the same. A character can be round without ever undergoing any changes throughout a story, so characters can be round without being dynamic.

If I'm understanding this right, I'm reading that a character that is fully developed, or round, is not dynamically changing because they do not need to for the story's sake. I understand in short stories or even long novels that it is possible to encounter static characters who are round and help to make a story interesting, but that's only because of their impact on the dynamic characters in that story. If a story was full of only static characters, it would get boring fast because you would always know how they are going to respond to a situation.

It is dynamic characters whose courage and change bring forth positive character development that makes stories meaningful. We connect with them as we notice growth we have experienced in our own stories.

I think this is one reason why God's plan to save the world through His Son is such an amazing blessing. Through Jesus' story, God (who appears as a static round character to our understanding), becomes a dynamic character to give us hope and direction that we can dynamically develop in our stories. He joins our story, that we can have hope for dynamic development in our character, to be more like Him! Tye
