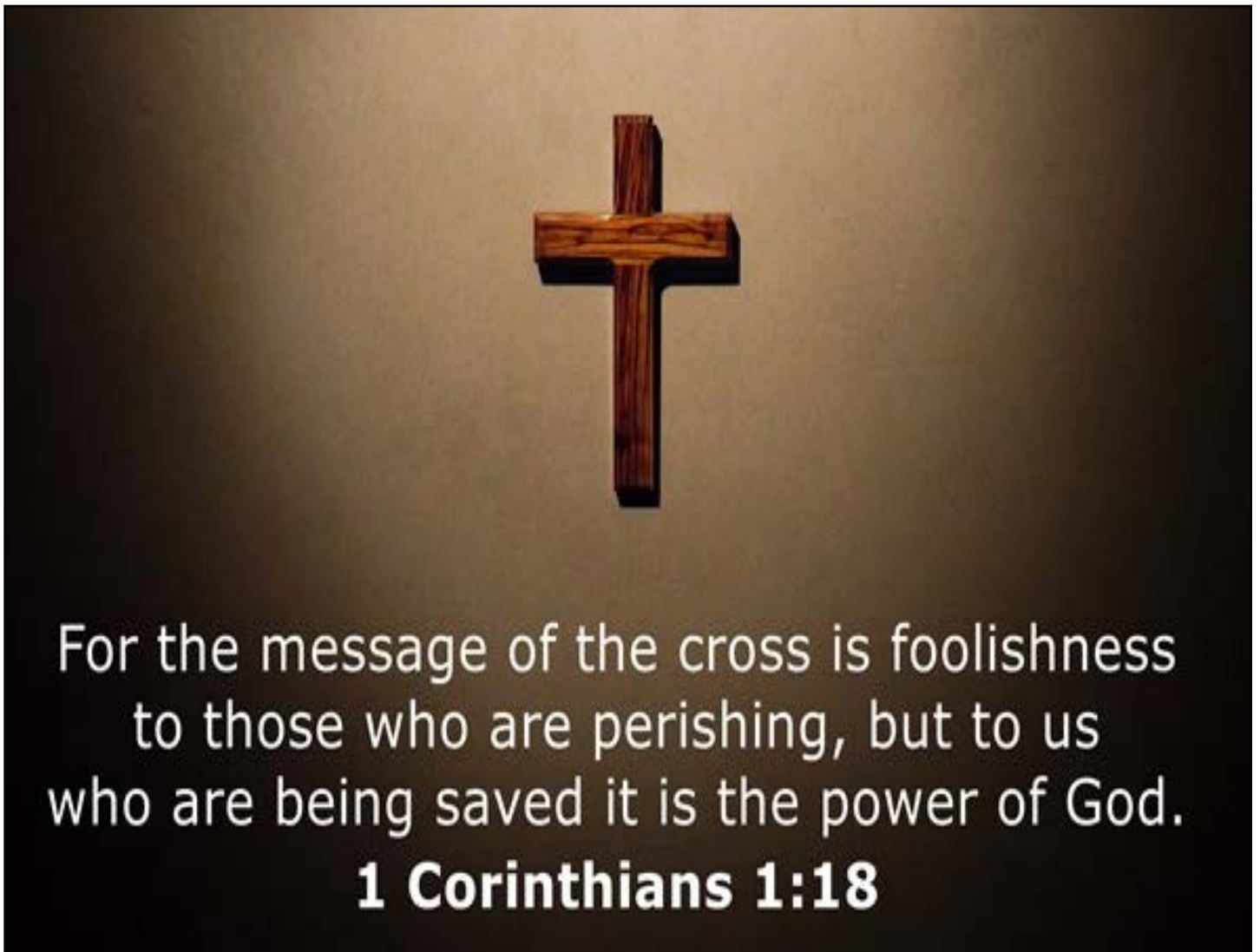

Story

Great story tellers have an amazing way of creating symbols of connection in the epic they are telling. Sometimes they clearly point out these symbols and carry them throughout their story, and sometimes these symbols show up as Easter eggs that are only noticed by the biggest fans of the story. These symbols create depth in the story, connecting themes and ideas in a way that awakens the imagination and wonder of those who read or view the story.

I think God has been doing this with the symbol of the cross. Have you noticed how clearly God carries this symbol throughout His story? Some of the symbols pointing to the cross are in your face all throughout scripture, such as Deuteronomy 21:23. A deep study of God's word begins to notice some of the less obvious examples of God's epic story telling abilities and His plan of fully overcoming conflict. The symbols are there for us to find and be in wonder and awe in God's story.

I believe God is still telling His story of His son dying on a cross through symbols that show up within our stories. Have you ever looked at the night sky and noticed cross shapes in the stars? Scientists have found cross shapes in the laminin proteins that are essential for our cells. God's use of the symbol of the cross is saying in our stories, "Look, be in awe and wonder, and remember the greatest story ever lived because I love you!" Tye

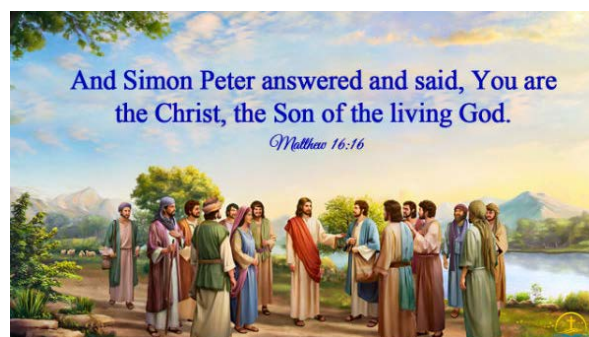
