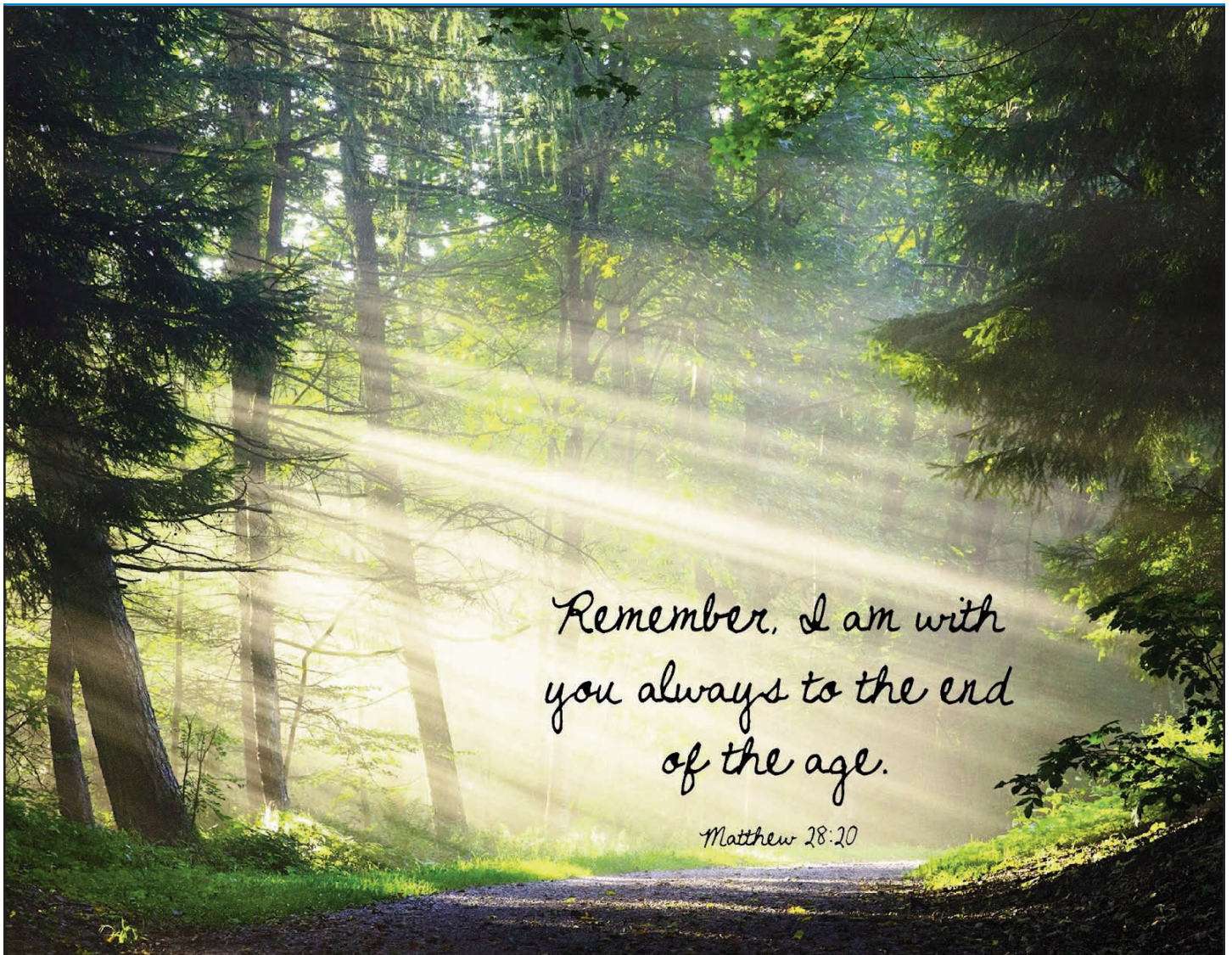

Outreach Sunday

A Special Request

If it is possible for you, would you consider moving to the front third of the auditorium for your regular seating on Sunday mornings. The reason for this request is to make our auditorium meet our needs longer. Our auditorium will seat over 500 people. But architects and our experiences tell us that when we reach 90% capacity, we have reached comfortable usable space.

While there always seems to be extra seats in the front third of the building, these spaces are not the most comfortable for visitors and those coming for the first few times. Currently, the way we as members are packing in the back third of the auditorium makes it difficult for visitors to find a seat without moving conspicuously nearer the front. [I suppose the fact some of us prefer a seat further back is shared by those who are not members.] We kind of know how they feel. Further, if we occupy the front third of the auditorium more to its capacity, we will be able to use it longer and more effectively. Unless we can begin to fill the front, we probably will not be able to grow much over 400 with the only empty spaces for visitors always in the front third of the auditorium. Thank you for your consideration in this.

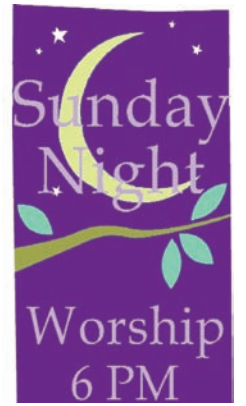
