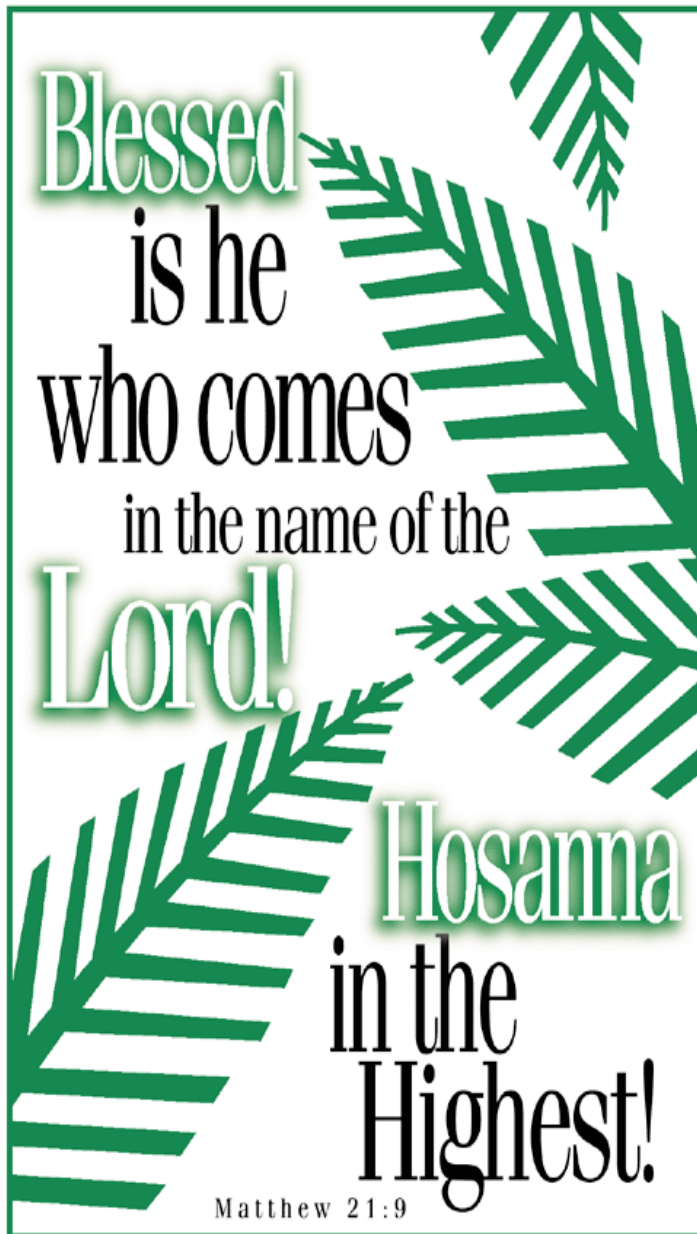

colt.’

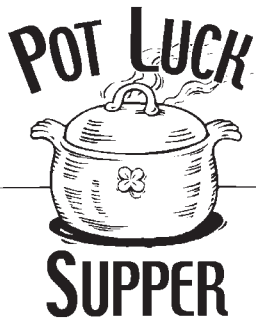
Some of the Pharisees in the crowd said to Jesus, ‘Teacher, rebuke your disciples!’ He replied,

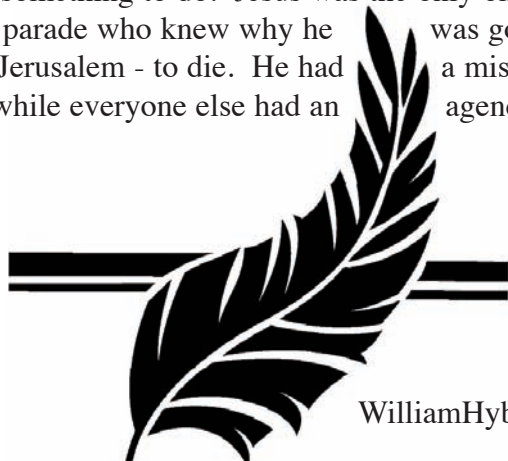

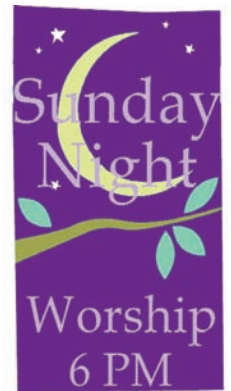
