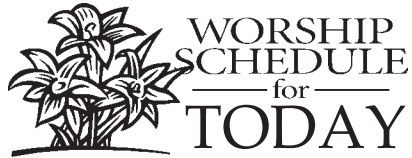
College Graduates - We need your graduation date, college attended, degree received and future plans.

Outreach Sunday

Our elders are challenging us again this year to expand our participation in the Mission of Jesus.

Sunday, May 4, a special Outreach Offering will be taken up to help us dedicate ourselves to greater service in our community and beyond. The money collected will be used in the following areas:

Bright Futures - A school program providing food for hungry children in Neosho.

Christian Counselor on staff - Salary for Ralph Madill as there is no charge to clients who come for counseling.

Church of Christ Disaster Relief - Nashville, TN, group that responds to disasters nation wide.

Crosslines - Local shelter providing for physical and spiritual needs of the homeless.

Delta Junction, Alaska, Church of Christ - Kevin Knight, minister.

Gospel Chariot Mission - Gospel outreach to cities and remote areas in Africa.

Handyman Ministry - Our men's outreach to complete projects for the elderly or needy.

Imagination Station - Our special class during preaching time for ages 3-8.

Kids' Konnection - Our special group Bible class offered to first through fourth graders.

Local Benevolence - Our outreach to the poor in Neosho and transients in need of special help.

Mid-Week Meal Ministry - Mid-week meal for members and their friends, neighbors, college students and single parent families in our area.

Mission Church in San Marcos, Ocotepaque

Mission Possible - Local program that feeds over 300 families each month.

Mission Ukraine - Orphan benevolence and church planting in Ukraine.

Neosho Christian School - Provide limited financial gift to assist viability of the school.

Pregnancy Care Center - A program assisting pregnant women with Christian options.

Teen Challenge - A local, Bible-based drug and alcohol rehabilitation program.

Touch A Life Foundation - A non-profit that rescues and rehabilitates trafficked children in Ghana, West Africa.
