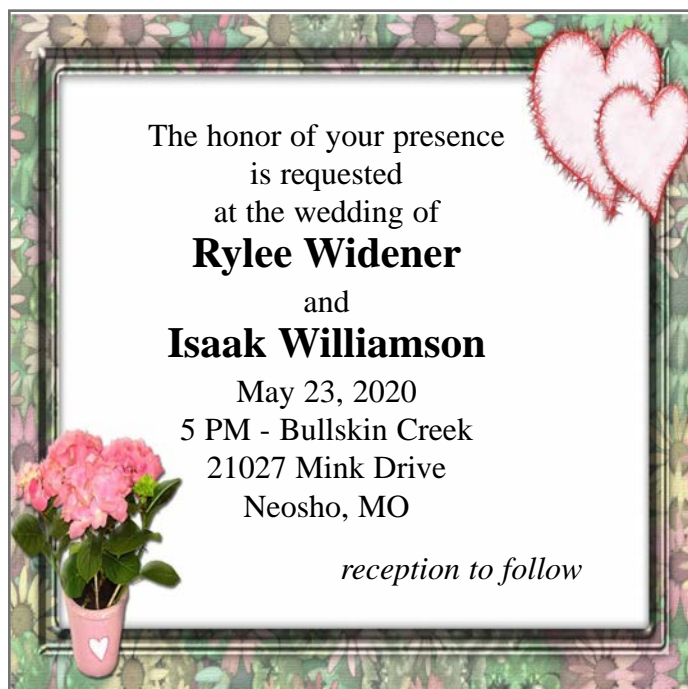
We express our sincere sympathy to Carl and Johnny Breckenridge. Their sister, Lawana Sandel, passed last week. Please keep all the family in your prayers.

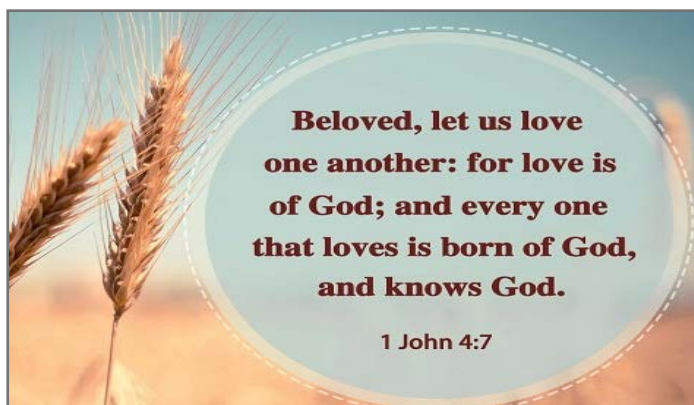

## Sunday, May 17th 10:30am Worship Service

We are prayerfully planning and looking forward to our worship together for next Sunday, May 17th, at 10:30am. As we have been blessed to continue to praise God by adjusting for our spiritual and physical health, we will continue in this blessing! Therefore, we will continue to live-stream our service so that anyone who cannot be together at the building can still be together as the body of Christ in worship.

For those that attend worship service at the building, there will be a few differences in order to help us worship God as we love our neighbors as ourselves. The west doors (carport) will be opened at 10:15am and a couple of our Deacons will be there to greet your family and give instructions of where to get communion supplies and masks and gloves if you would like to have them. The auditorium seating has been arranged so that each family can sit together and a few ushers will be available to help find groups of chairs that will fit your needs. We will have communion following the sermon so that you will not be holding the empty cups for very long and dispose of them as you leave the auditorium. We will encourage fellowship outside (if the weather is good) instead of the foyer so that we can have plenty of room to be with each other and share life. Please bring your own masks if you would like and masks will also be available here at the building. Hand sanitizers will be available also.

This will be a full worship service where we can praise God and be His people together, through live-streaming or in person! The service will be a bit shorter, but it will be full of joy and hope as we continue have Kingdom Vision for 2020!
