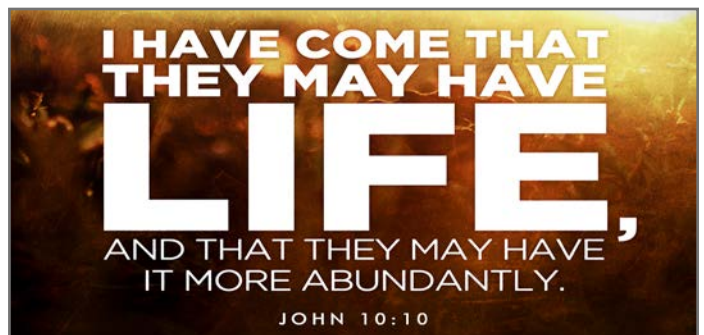
Invitations have a way of changing your plans, your thinking, and even your hopes. They change your outlook on the future and your current path to get there. You can see this truth when a child receives an invitation for a friend's birthday party. They begin planning what they will wear, preparing for whatever activity the invitation says they will engage in. Excitement for shopping for their friend's present reveals that they really don't think of only themselves as their focus becomes inward and outward in hopeful expectation that their friend will love their gift. And their energy level grows as the date gets closer and closer.

You can see this truth in adults when they are invited over for dinner. Calendars are immediately opened to see if the invitation can be accepted, and many events are rescheduled to make room for the joy of being with others. Questions like, "What can I bring?" and "Honey, should we get them a candle (or some other gift)?" are asked by those invited as they look forward to a time spent with their friends.

Invitations bring promises of blessing and the hope of joy in fellowship. A sense of belonging and connection is shared.
