- ◆ Able to provide adequate structure, consistency and boundaries
- ◆ Able to be supportive, nurturing, accessible and have time and energy
- ◆ Able to maintain focus on goals, strengths, successes as well as needs
- ◆ Capable of recognizing control issues and utilizing proactive styles of communication
- ◆ Knowledgeable of loss, possible reactions to traumatic events and the grief process
- ◆ Stay current and positive as much as possible with personal and community relationships
- ◆ Appreciative of team members and have the ability to recognize when involvement and resources are needed

These attributes may be worded differently, but they represent some of what Jesus did for others as He served the Father. All of us have experienced varied levels of loss. Allowing Jesus, the Word and the Holy Spirit to help us become experienced and capable "Loss Managers" is a worthy and wise goal. Ralph

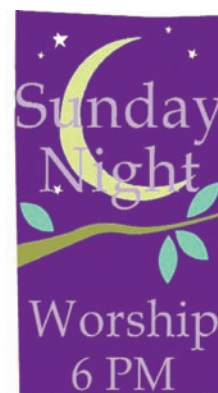
