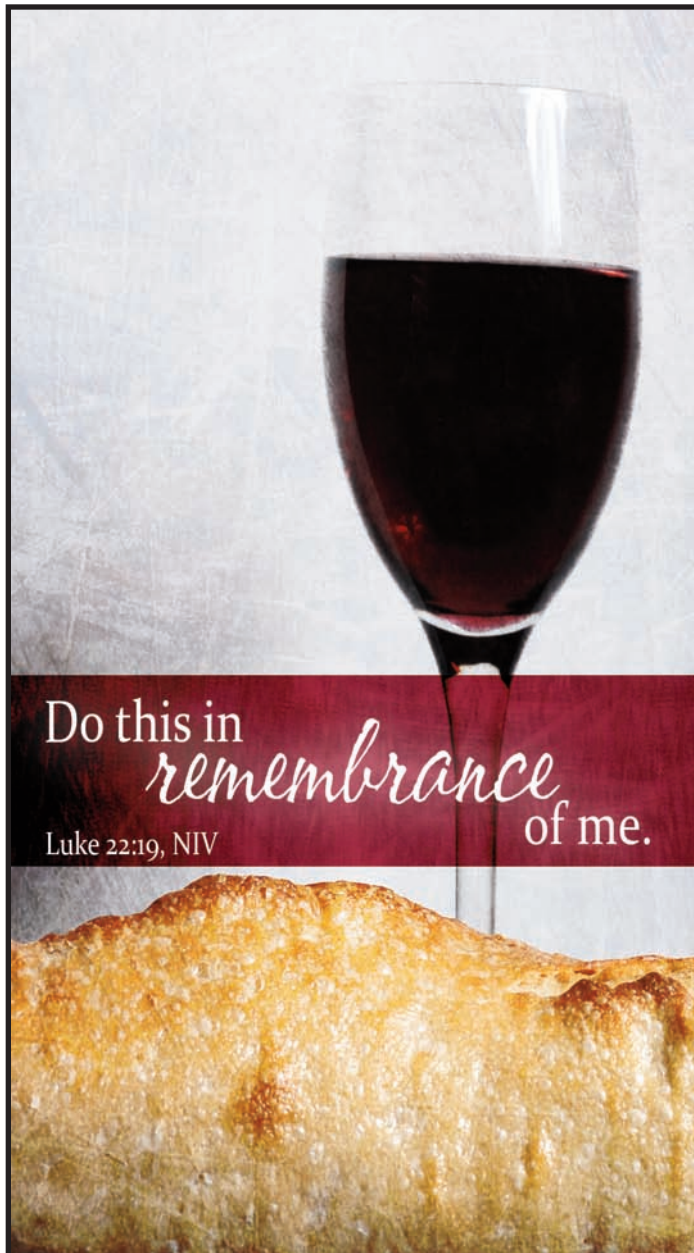

### Joplin Tornado Work Report - Sr. Youth & Others

Members of our youth group have worked every day this week in Joplin. Monday: Delivered clothes to 2 families, searched homes, helped families searching for belongings, rescued 3 dogs from a collapsed home & prayed constantly. Tuesday & Wednesday: We helped people move whole floors to find important items, made paths for vehicles, worked with search & rescue teams, prayed, removed fallen trees, helped tarp a roof, rescued a man under a fallen tree. Thursday: Helped Mt. Hope C of C with deliveries, cleared debris, helped tarp a roof and move items. Friday: Helped with search & rescue and delivering goods to Mt. Hope. The teens & other volunteers were amazing. We provided more help in five days than we normally do over a year! Nathan Weston was near an exploding gas main while helping Sunday night & received shrapnel in his cheek. He has worked every night since with search & rescue. May God continue to bless the work going on in Joplin.

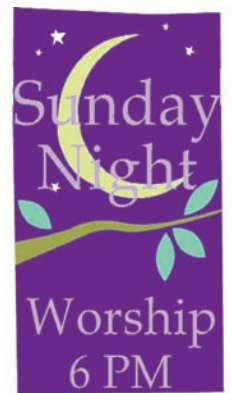
