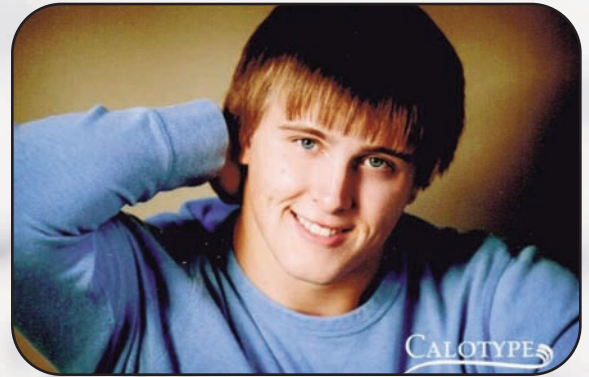
We had a total of **47** children last week. Thank you Auntie Sheri and all of our helpers for helping us learn about sharing and kindness!

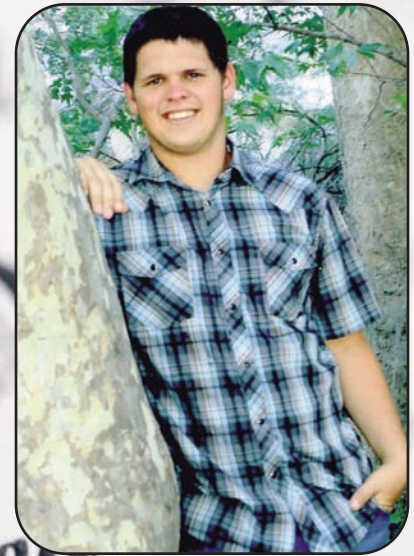

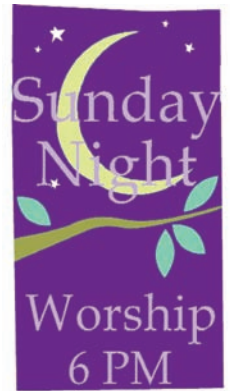
