There will be a baby shower for Samantha Beeson this afternoon at 3 p.m. at the Harmony Street building.

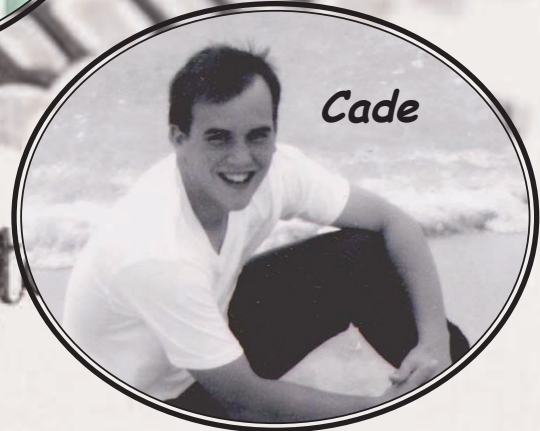


SNT - 7-9 pm - We will be fishing at the Lane's house. Leaving from Harmony St. building at 6:30 and returning by 9 pm.

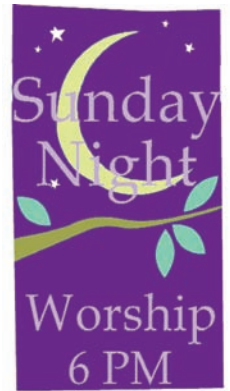
