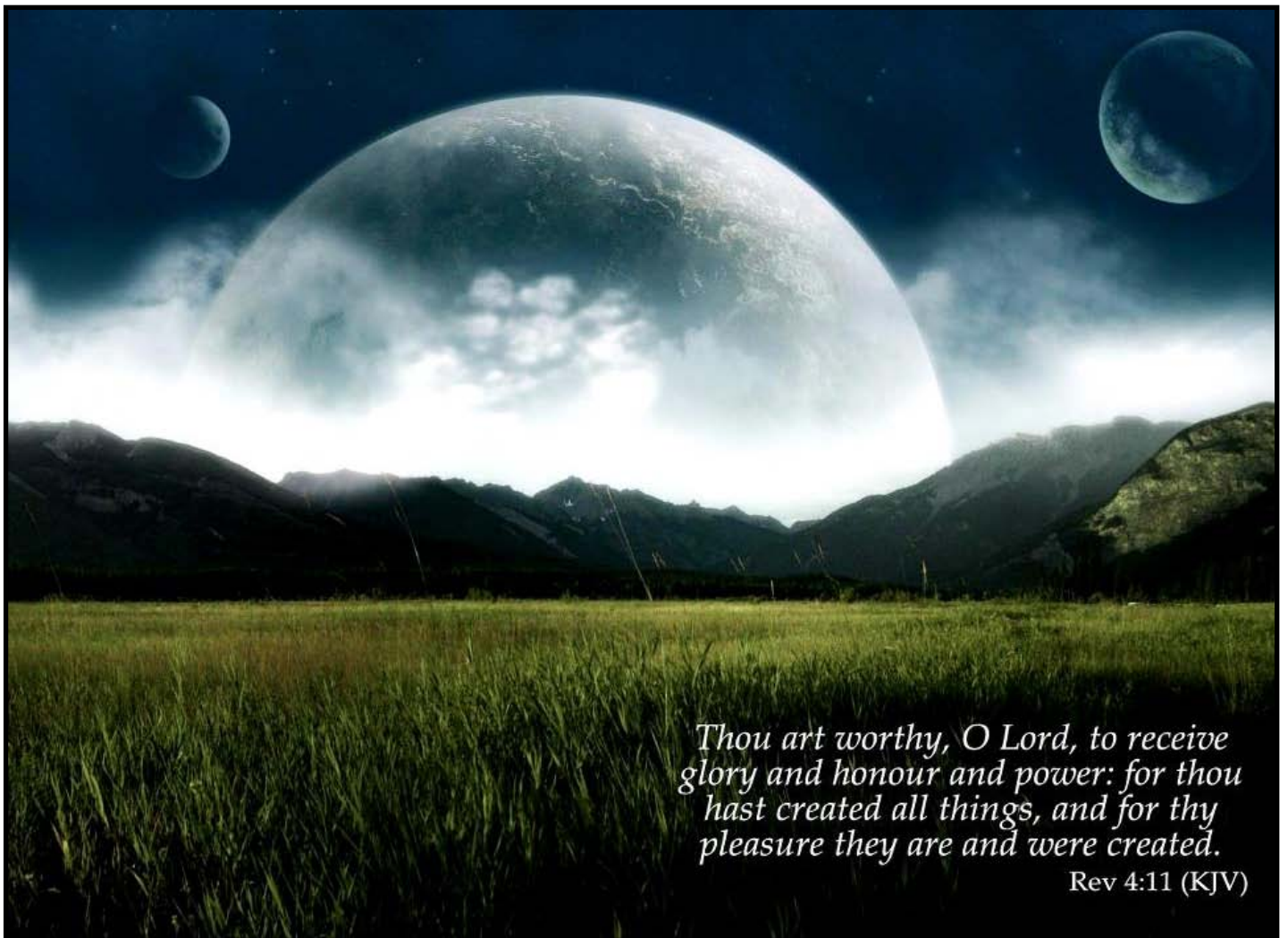

Our special Outreach Offering to help us dedicate ourselves to greater service in our community and beyond will be taken up Sunday, May 20th. Money collected will be used in the following areas:

Belize Mission - A team ministering to dental, medical, and spiritual needs in impoverished areas.

Bright Futures - A school program providing food for hungry children in East Newton & Neosho schools.

Christian Counselor on staff - Salary for Ralph Madill as there is no charge to clients who come for services.

Christian Youth Camps - Scholarships for Green Valley Bible Camp and Little Prairie Bible Camp.

Churches of Christ Disaster Relief - Group that responds to disasters nation wide.

Gospel Chariot Mission - Gospel outreach to cities and remote areas in Africa.

Hope Kitchen - A Christ inspired community effort to feed the hungry.

Imagination Station - Our special class for young children during preaching time.

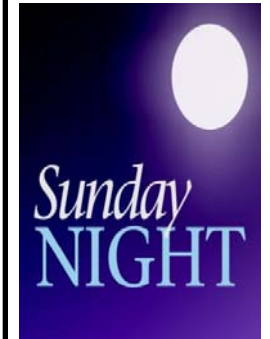
