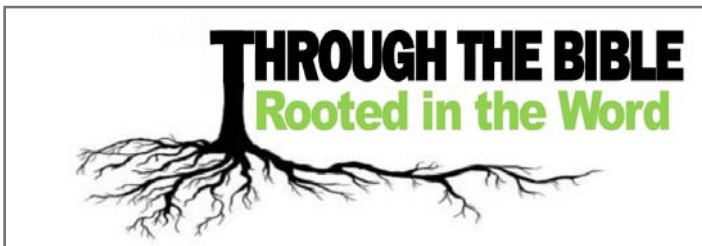

He's Still Working on Me

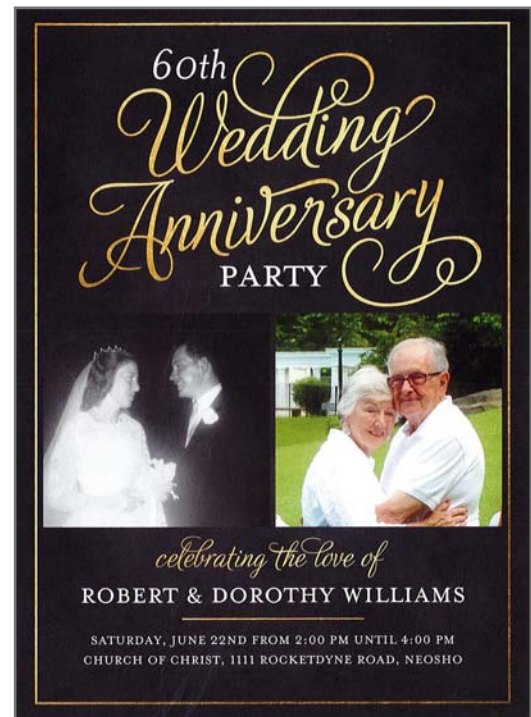
